COWTOWN MARATHON AND 10K

February 29, 1992, Fort Worth: 9:00 A.M. 63 degrees, 851 marathoners start their trek through the streets of "Cowntown" and felt the effect of the constantly rising temperature which hit 78 degrees by noon. 704 runners finished with some torturing themselves for over 6 hours. The 10K started at 9:20 A.M. with 12,982 starting and over 10,577 recording a finish time. WEST TEXAS RUNNING CLUB was represented pretty well with Jeffrey Jury recording a PR of 3:02:37 and finishing 24th overall.
