RED RAIDER ROAD RACE  
RACE DIRECTOR'S REPORT

The 11th Edition of the Red Raider Road Race featured the largest field of the past five years, with nearly 380 registrants. The 52° temperature at racetime may have been a little crisp for spectators, but it was ideal for the participants. Under sunny but breezy conditions, nine runners sped to new age-group records. Dan Buford of Lubbock claimed the men's overall title in the 5K in 16:46, while Kay Schmidt of Alpine smashed her own previous age-group record enroute to the women's 5K title in 20:39. Steve Cathcart of Las Vegas, NM recorded one of the fastest road 10K's run in Lubbock during the past several years, blazing through 6.2 miles in 31:38, a scant 9 seconds off the overall course record. Lori Dellis of Amarillo captured the women's 10K crown in 44:47.

This year's event featured the debut of special awards for the outstanding performances by a male and female masters runner (age 40 and over) in each race. To determine the winners of these awards, each 40-and-over runner's time was age-graded, based upon tables from the *National Master's News*, the authoritative publication covering masters' running. Caylene Caddell of Lubbock turned in the outstanding female master's performance in the 5K, while 55-year-old Gary Schmidt's time of 18:48 earned the Alpine, TX runner the outstanding male master's 5K award. The outstanding female master's award in the 10K was claimed by Teresa Greer of Lubbock who lowered her own age-group record. George Jury of Lubbock earned the outstanding male master's award in the 10K with a time of 39:15. The 56-year-old runner finished in the top 10 overall and lowered the 55-59 age-group record by 2:25.

This year's event enjoyed the support of three major sponsors: Cardinal's Sport Centers, Lubbock National Bank, and University Medical Center. Because of the generosity of these sponsors, all proceeds from the race benefit the Texas Tech Ex-Students Association/West Texas Running Club Scholarship Fund, given each year to a Tech Student. Christye Marez of Abertmahy is the 1992 recipient of this scholarship.

Directing the 1992 Red Raider Road Race was a pleasure due to the veritable 'army' of volunteers who pitched in to help. George Jury worked tirelessly months before the race to secure TAC certification of the 5K and 10K courses. He also secured the major sponsors, provided instruction to volunteers, and along with Jeffrey Jury, set up the course at 6 a.m. on race morning. Patricia Jury spent countless hours entering participants into the computer system and working long shifts at late registration. She also helped compile the race results. The Texas Tech Ex-Students' Association provided invaluable help in the persons of Jim Douglass, Susan Bowen who handled all of the pre-registration mail, and Don Johnston who designed the beautiful t-shirt and designed and printed the posters and entry forms. Sincere thanks go to Dee Ann Salsky of Phil Price Advertising for her firm's longtime support of this race and their contribution of original artwork and design. Tom Weis and Ralph Kleinsmith graciously extended to us the resources of the Student Recreation Center. Ron Key was at the University Center all day on Friday and at the finish line throughout the race, in order to provide us with computerized race results. Mike Greer served as race announcer and was assisted by Michelle Jones. The finish line was staffed by Roger McClain, Ida Sumpter, Christye Marez, Teresa Harn, Andy Harn, and David Rodriguez. Dennis Bell and Lawrence Nelson helped to set up the finish line at 6 a.m. and dismantled it after the race. Larry Reno, Jon Masood, and Ronnie Nugent joined with Pat Jury and Ron Key in staffing the registration table on Friday. Saturday morning registration and packet pickup was staffed by Ron Key, Sandi Howard, Lydia Lemus, Michelle Jones, Larry Byrd, Mike Kelley, Phil Hur, and David Rodriguez. Race packets were prepared by Brad Jury. Ronnie Nugent, his daughter Angela, and Jon Masood served as split timers during the race. Marlin Hamilton once again served as bicycle race leader. For the second year in a row, members of the ITU chapter of the National Student Speech-Language-Hearing Association, along with faculty from the Dept. of Speech and Hearing Sciences, served as water stop volunteers and corner marshals. Thanks also to the Tech Police for traffic control and Grounds Maintenance for providing barricades.

Our primary goal was to provide a safe and enjoyable race for each of the 378 runners participating in this year's races. The field included a few runners who have completed all eleven Red Raider Road Races as well as many running in their first race. We were especially pleased to welcome several high school and jr. high cross-country team members who took advantage of a lull in their meet schedules to get in a road race. Finally, it was great to see the many Tech alumni who made the race a special part of their Homecoming weekend.

The 12th Annual Red Raider Road Race will be held on October 16, 1993. On behalf of the Texas Tech Ex-Students' Association and the West Texas Running Club, thanks for coming, and we hope to see you at the starting line next year!

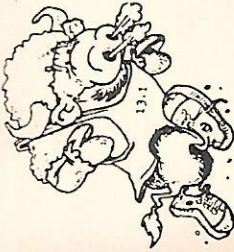
