

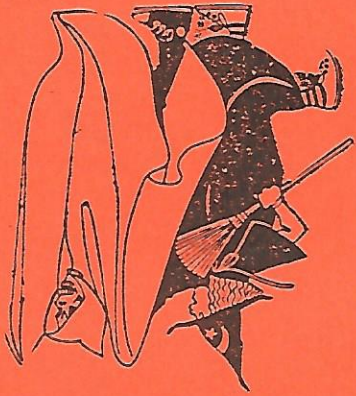

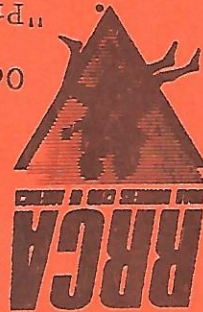

PREDICTED TIME RACE

The club voted to try this different type of race venue at the August business meeting. Since then, the editor has seen results from a couple of other Predicted Time events across the state. This should be a nice change from our usual races where we all check our watch or listen for a split timer's call at the mile marks. Even the big clock will not be visible at the finish line. At registration each runner must guess at their finish time and become eligible for one of the cash prizes to be awarded. The course itself is precisely measured (centrifugal) but offers several small hills which should shake the monotony of a simple flat course. See page 11 for more information.
