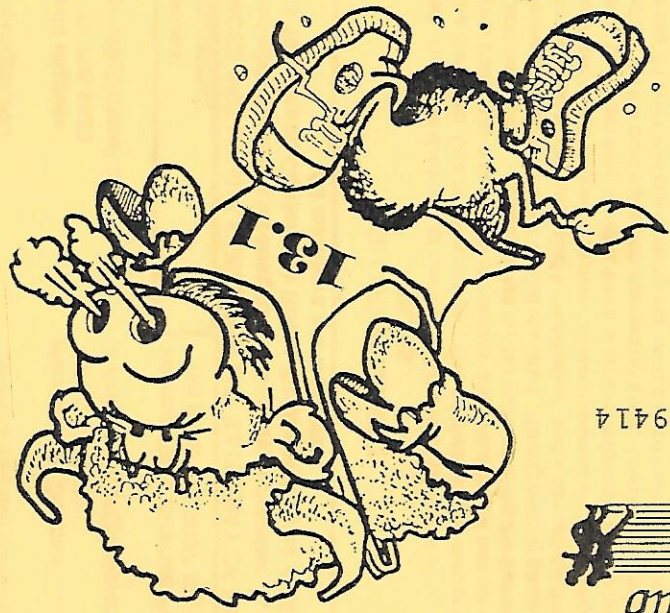

RACE HELP NEEDED

Volunteers are needed for the BUFFALO WALLOW. Call George at 792-3291 (d) or 792-1237 (n). You will get 13.1 miles credit toward the 66 mile club.

We don't have an official director for the TURKEY TROT, Thanksgiving day, November 23rd, and we have very few who have volunteered to help. Remember last year we had over 200 participants so it is an important event. Many of you who want to run could be a tremendous help in areas that would still let you run. At late registration we need a cashier, a race number dispenser, a packet distributor and someone to guide people to fill out the forms. These volunteers would need to be there by 7:15 am. We need someone who will fill and haul the water and sport drink containers and take care of them afterward. We have a volunteer already committed to set out the mile markers. We will need at least two people to man the 2 water stops and one person to stand at the one mile mark to turn back the 2 milers (calling split time), then move to the turn around point for the 12K. If we have to, we could just enlist spectators to help at the finish line. This race brings a lot of people from out of town, so let's keep our reputation intact for putting on quality events! SUSAN KOMEN RACE FOR THE CURE

The area's first cool weather welcomed runners to this year's event which raises funds to support research and treatment for breast cancer. The Komen races are among the largest in the country, and the Lubbock 5k race and 1 mile fun run are easily the largest Lubbock has ever seen. Our finish line recorded 1425 finishers in the longer race, with 3000 as the registered total. Haffis Banire breezed through the 5k looped course in 17:17 as the first overall male; the Lubbock massage therapist seems to lead in cold or hot weather. In the ladies overall race Lori Ioppolo took first in 19:55, just ahead of experienced winners Janda Ibbetson and Hope Jimenez. Lori has begun to show her speed at a few area road races this year; we should see more wins soon. Masters winners were Wade Wilson in 20:50 and Martha Martinez in 24:16.

Dr. George Jury is the club's rep who has managed our timing of the event for the past few years. But this year, George was sidelined with an inflamed appendix leading to surgery. Club members stepped in to follow George's organization plan for a successful completion. Special thanks to David Higgins for managing the computer timing and results. A rapid processing made all the results available soon after the race, with glitches ironed out as well. As with all club events, many people pitched in to make a packed, four chute finish line run like the big time races. Four of our members were able to finish the gruelling 2000 version of the original IRONMAN TRIATHLON on October 14th. The Lubbock AJ's Don Williams did a nice race day write up on the contestants and their results were printed in the Monday, Oct. 16th paper.

The event of course consists of a 2.4 mile swim, a 112 mile bike ride, then the full marathon at the end. Tim Key was 194th overall in a time of 10:09:58, Marti Greer was 1,299th overall with a 14:26:33, Jimmie Key was 1,330th overall with a 14:58:38 and Mike Greer posted a 15:45:37 for 1,376th overall. There were over 1,600 starters and approximately 1,426 finished.

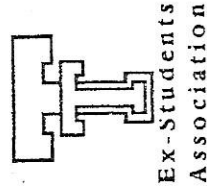
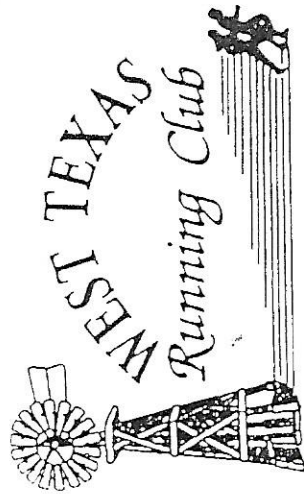

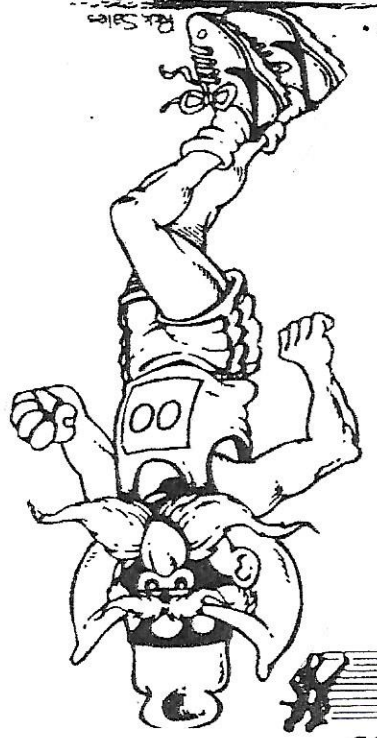
