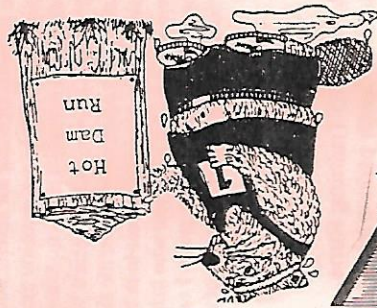

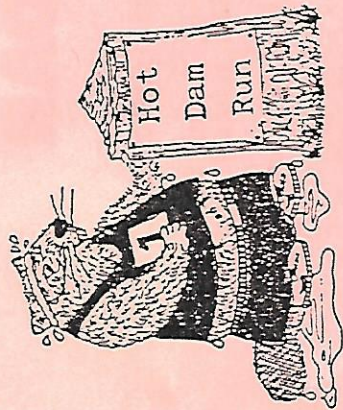

RACE COURSE CERTIFICATION

When you run a race on a certified course you can be assured that you will never run on a short course. A certified course is one that has been measured according to the standards set out by the Road Running Technical Committee (RRTC) of the U.S.A. TRACK and FIELD Association. (USA T&F) A recent ruling at the annual meeting allows a certified course only a 10 year life when it must be re-measured, if there is any doubt about the location of the permanent marks for all points. There is a provision for renewing certification which will extend the course life for another 10 years if the original measurer/certifier can affirm that all markers are still present. We currently have 2 calibration courses and 9 race courses that are active. Two courses are inactive. I will be working on the paper work to extend certification for another 10 years on 9 of these. Because of the constant construction on the Tech Campus trying to re-certify the two RRRR distances will be too big a job. However, you can be assured that you will run accurate courses this fall even though we will have to make some changes due to construction that alters the 18th and Flint intersection. 32ND ANNUAL FIRECRACKER RUN

This year's Firecracker Run was successful with 194 participants. We even had finishers from Colorado, Arkansas, Oklahoma and New Mexico. Our total attendance tied last year's record with the following finishers in each race:
66 10 milers; 89 3 milers; 39 1 milers (children's race)

Several records were broken this year. Melanie McVey improved her own record in the 35-39 category to 21:34 for 3 miles. In the 10 mile race, 71 year old Don Sanderson established the 70+ record of 1:21:07 as he won the 60+ age group. 18 year old Stephanie Bigham, of Idalou, set the 19 and under ladies record of 1:15:14. PJ Mitchell, not only volunteered, but also set a new 50+ female record of 1:29:55. Finally, a 26 year record was broken this year by SPC student, Sam Awape. 19 year old Sam ran a 52:54 10 mile race which is only 20 seconds off of the overall record. Congratulations to all record breakers. We look forward to several more being broken next year. Assistant D.A., Ashley Cox, joined us this year trying to raise money to help prevent domestic violence. Ashley and a running mate will be running The Rock as their first marathon. She will be collecting money for "Project Save" as she runs to help victims of domestic violence. We look forward to seeing her at the Hot Dam this year.
