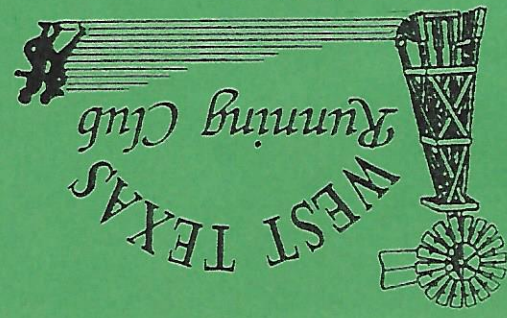

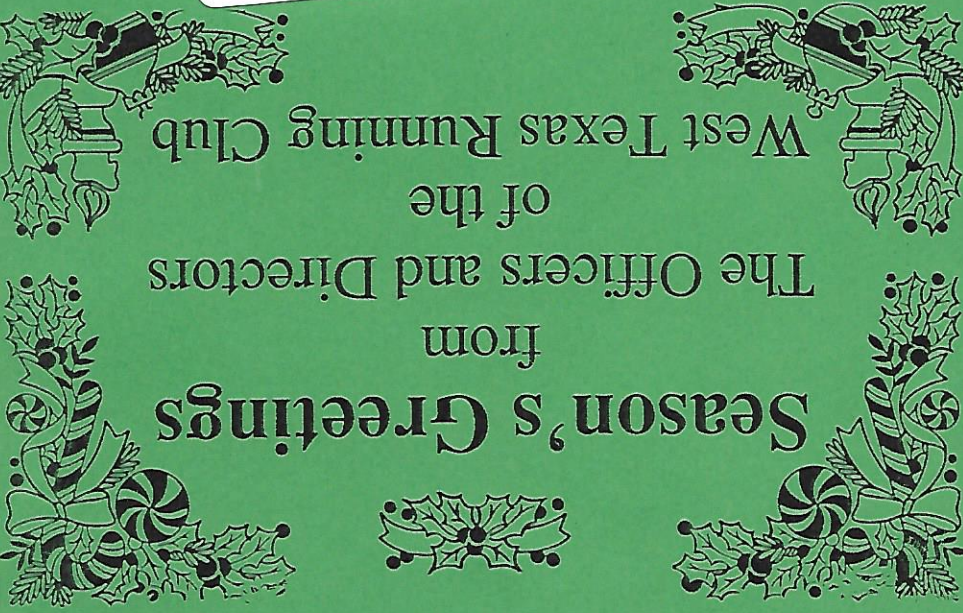

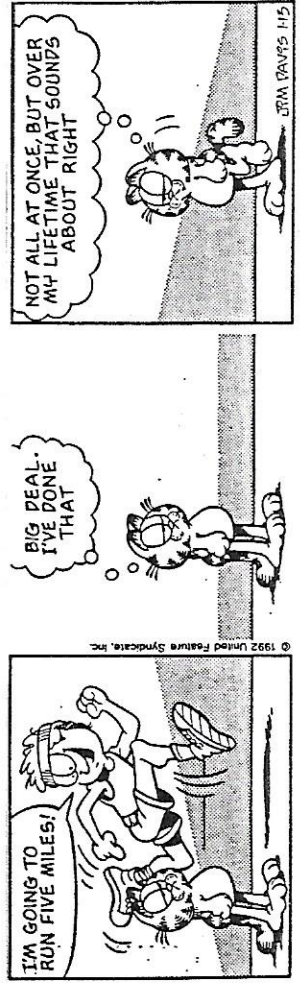

PALO DURO TRAIL RUN

There were a record 150 runners in the 20K, 50K, and 50 mile races on October 24th at Palo Duro Canyon. Three WTRC members completed the 50K event, with Diane Calhoun leading the way. Diane finished 1st among the women runners with a time of 5:39:41 over the hilly course. David Steadman finished in 5:42:35, and Weldon Kolb logged a time of 6:22:09.

IRONMAN FLORIDA

Tim Key finished 20th overall in a strong field of national and international triathletes at Panama City, Florida on November 10th. There were over 1800 finishers in this full ironman event which Tim finished in 9 hours 18 minutes--a personal best!

WHITE ROCK HALF MARATHON

This year's White Rock Half was run over a challenging and hilly course. James Wickersham was there to complete his first half marathon in a very solid 2:06:09.

WILLIE NELSON'S 10K FOR FARM AID

The club was well represented in this event with four finishers among the 1680 who completed the event. Mike Flores finished 1st in the 45-49 age group with a time of 40:48; P.J. Mitchell captured 1st in the women age group 55-59 with a time of 55:07; Larry Byrd covered the 10K distance in 58:10; and Bob Bernero ran a 1:00:51.

NEW YORK CITY MARATHON

P.J. Mitchell participated in this year's New York City Marathon as a member of the Achilles Track Club, assisting another runner with a disability to a finishing time of 4:57.

SAN ANTONIO MARATHON

Traveling to San Antonio to compete as a relay were James Bone, Larry Byrd, Joe Martinez and Bill Roger. James and Joe ran a 4:12:21 in the "Masters" division and Larry and Bill ran a 4:09:37 in the "Seniors" division.

HIGH SCHOOL CROSS COUNTRY

Nearly all the best cross country runners in the area are club members. All of them won their respective district meets, beginning with Mindy Sullivan in the District 1-5A, Casey Sumpter and Hope Jimenez in District 3-3A, Cody Turner in 2-3A, and Heather Waygood in 4-2A.

At the regional meet, November 3rd, Mindy Sullivan finished second to Monique Ortega of El Paso Montwood by .5 second, 11:07.4 to 11:07.9! In the 3A boys race, Casey Sumpter won in a time of 16:12.8, Cody Turner was 5th in 16:49 and Hope Jimenez was second in the girls race in 12:08.4. Heather Waygood of Sundown was 4th in class 2A, with a 12:44.2. The first 10 individuals automatically earn a trip to the State meet in Round Rock. Three other youngsters who frequently run our races also qualified for state; Jared Davis of Whiteface in class 1A, Rocky Reyes of Floydada in 2A and Josh Hawkins of Frenship in 4A.

STATE CHAMPIONS!

Mindy Sullivan conquered the course at Round Rock, winning the 5A girls championship with a time of 10:46 which was a new course record as well! Casey Sumpter also was a winner, besting the class 3A boys with a time of 16:19.5. Cody Turner was 18th with a time of 17:45. Hope Jimenez finished second in the 3A girls race, running 11:40.6 to the winner's 11:21.6. Heather Waygood was 25th in the girls 2A race with a time of 12:37. Josh Hawkins of Frenship was ninth in the 4A boys race with a time of 16:06. Coach Ken Jernigan's Miles High School girls team won the Championship in class 1A.
