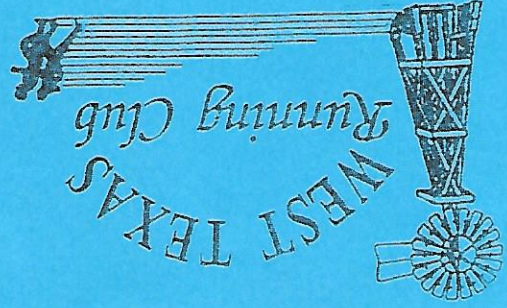

ASTRONAUTS AND PRESIDENTS

There have been all sorts of people participating in WTRC events over the years. A recent article in the Lubbock Avalanche-Journal focused on two men with Lubbock connections scheduled to participate in a NASA space flight this coming July. One of them, William C. "Willie" McCool was a cross country runner at Lubbock Coronado who participated in several WTRC events back in the late 1970's. McCool graduated from Coronado in 1979 and went on to attend the US Naval Academy where he graduated second in his class of 1,083 in 1983. He also has advanced degrees from the University of Maryland and the US Naval Postgraduate school. A check of some old race results showed Willie McCool running a 27:28 5 mile race in Brownfield on August 9, 1980, and at the age of 16, a 16:02 three mile effort in Brownfield on July 4, 1978. Interestingly enough, that 3 mile race also had George W. Bush completing the event in 20:11. President-elect Bush was 31 years old at that time. There were 49 finishers in that 3 mile run. Next time you line up at one of our races, take a good look at the people surrounding you. You never know what kind of accomplishments they may attain. After all, we had a future astronaut and president in one little race in Brownfield, Texas!

REDLINE RACE REPORT

The end of high school and collegiate cross country seasons allowed quite a few younger runners to compete in the Redline 4 mile race this year. Leading the way in the men's division was Josephat Keino of South Plains College in 21:28. Mindy Sullivan of Lubbock Coronado won in the women's race with a time of 27:52.
