

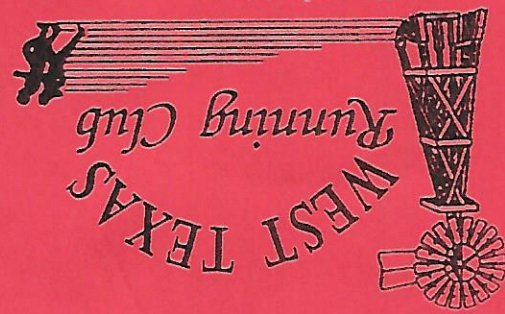

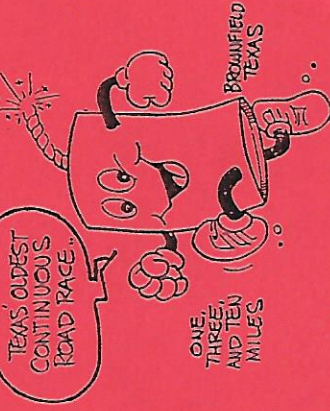

**NEW HIGH SCHOOL MILE RECORD**

Webb Breaks Ryan's Scholastic Mile Record  
(edited by GWJ)

EUGENE, Ore., May 27th, Alan Webb, a high school senior from Reston, Va., finished fifth today in the mile run at the Prefontaine Classic and then took a victory lap. And then he took another.

After breaking Jim Ryan's 36-year-old scholastic record by nearly two seconds, Webb basked in the salute of 11,211 fans at Hayward Field.

Webb's time, 3 minutes 53.43 seconds, shattered the record of 3:55.3 set by Ryan in 1965 in San Diego.

Webb put the hallowed four-minute-mile barrier behind him in January, with 14-hundredths of a second to spare. He was not so kind to this milestone.

Webb has overwhelmed his high school competition, running the anchor legs for two winning teams at the prestigious Penn Relays last month. But it is in open competition, against the world's elite runners, that he has established himself as the best scholastic distance runner in decades.

It was in an open race in January, at the Armory Track and Field Center in Manhattan, that Webb ran a mile in 3:59.86, becoming the first American high school runner to break four minutes indoors and the first to do so anywhere since 1967.

And it was in an open race today that Webb shattered the record set by Ryan, now a United States congressman from Kansas.

Along the way to his record today, Webb was timed in 3:38.26 for 1,500 meters, breaking Ryan's mark of 3:39.0.

The winner of today's mile race was Hicham el-Guerrouj of Morocco, who holds the world record of 3:43.13.

Guerrouj's time of 3:49.92 was the fastest outdoor mile run in the United States, but almost everyone was watching Webb, 30 yards down the track, fight for fourth place with Adil Kaouch.

Webb, 18, from South Lakes High School, missed by a foot, but a look at the scoreboard clock showed he was well under Ryan's record.

"I was trying to hold him off, and he got me," said Webb, who will run at the University of Michigan in the fall. "But I looked at the clock and saw I'd done what I came for, so I felt pretty good."

Webb ran the first half of the race toward the back of a 13-man pack, with Guerrouj alone in front behind two designated pace-setters.

Webb's split for the first quarter-mile was 58.1 seconds, more than 3 seconds behind Guerrouj's 54.9.

"I felt good the whole time," Webb said. "I thought the pace was pretty fast at first, and I stayed back. When I heard my split of 58, I knew I was on pace and I thought, 'I guess I have it today.'"
