

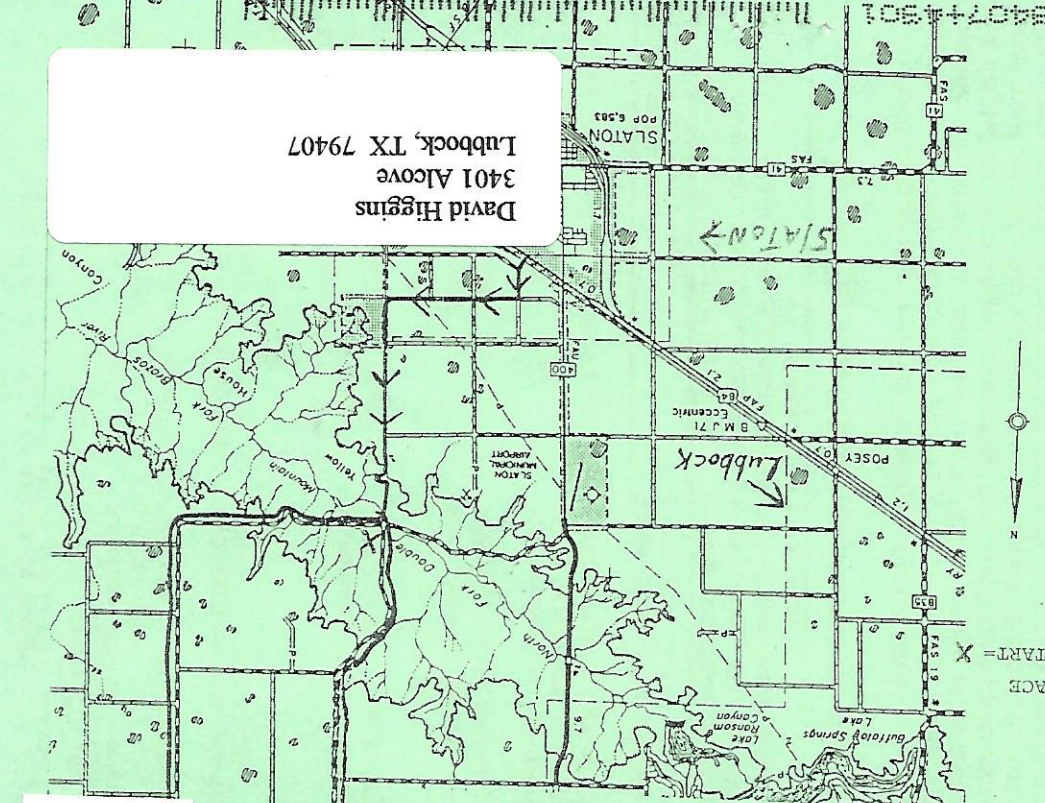

RUNNING WITH ALAN

At dawn one day last October, I had the pleasure of one of those long, slow runs with another runner. You know the kind of run, slow enough to have a conversation and not get too winded, enjoyable enough that at the end you feel like you could have gone on for another hour or two.

This run was especially nice since it was with a man I had known only for a few hours and since he was an interesting person who also happens to be a bona fide fanatic when it comes to running.

For those who are too young to know about the Purple People Eaters of professional football, they were an awesome group of defensive players for the Minnesota Vikings back in the 1970's and 1980's. Alan Page was one of the Viking linemen who regularly beat up on the Dallas Cowboys and other NFL teams.

Page was in Hobbs to deliver a talk about education and the judicial system in America. He is no longer in professional football. While he was still playing, he worked on a law degree and is now a justice in the Minnesota Supreme Court.

When we did our dawn run on a cool, October morning, we did not talk about football or law. We talked mostly about our families and our running.

Page runs every day, and he misses only when extreme circumstances prevent him. When he does miss, he told me, he feels terrible. He is a trim 240 pounds, down 30 or 40 pounds from the early days in the Viking trenches.

All of his family, wife and grown kids, run too. One of his daughters was preparing to compete in the Chicago Marathon. Running is one of the things they have shared that has kept them close as the kids have gone on to have their own families.

Page is a quiet and bright man who would have been a success at any profession he might have chosen, and his dedication to running in his mid fifties is a reflection of the kind of dedication and commitment that he has brought to other worthwhile pursuits in his life.

Many of those pursuits have been philanthropic. He has given much money and many years of his life to helping disadvantaged Americans, especially the young.

When we finished our 75 minute run, we talked some more as the sun came up. We talked of how much running has meant to us and how it has become a part of our family traditions.

Page just might be a role model for all of us, young and old, and I hope that some day much of the country will take the selfless turns and run the kind of giving race Page does.

We would be a much better nation.

Running with Alan on a humid, fall morning was an invigorating experience for me.

In the hundreds of good runs I have had over the years, it was one of those that I will look back on and say, "This is why I love running."

The WEST TEXAS RUNNING CLUB scholarship at TEXAS TECH UNIVERSITY was established and criteria defined in the fall of 1989. This endowment fund, derived from the proceeds of the RED RAIDER ROAD RACE, had grown large enough that an award could be made. The stipend is now \$500 per semester for two semesters.
 The scholarship selection committee to be named, will make the selection of recipients by August 15, 2001.

RECOMMENDED CRITERIA:

The person selected will be chosen without regard to age, race, sex, religion, color, national origin, marital status, ancestry or handicap.
 1) Non-Academic/ Non-Athletic Scholarship
 --> 2) Must have letter of recommendation by a W.T.R.C. Member

- 3) Applicants will submit a standardized form approved by the selection committee
- 4) Recipient must be from West Texas as defined: The area north of Interstate 20 as far west as Pecos and west of a line from Abilene to Wichita Falls
- 5) Recipient must have a GPA of 2.5 after at least one semester at TTU and maintain that GPA during the scholarship period
- 6) Major Area of study can be any
- 7) Full time student status; at least 12 hours undergrad
- 8) Restriction: Recipient must have a verified Financial Need

Deadline is August 1, 2001
