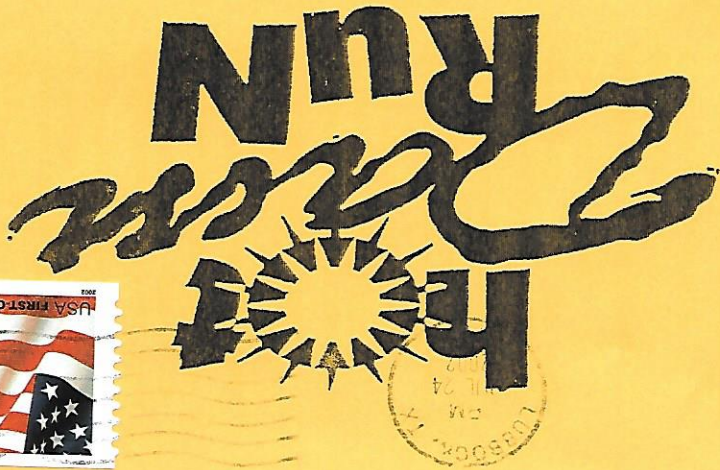

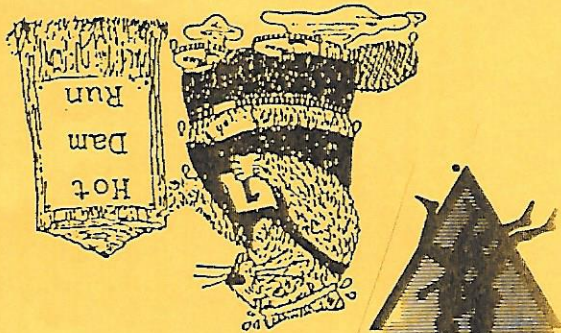

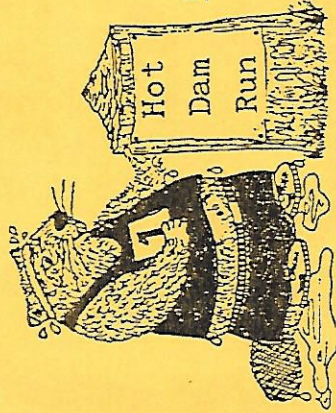

NOTES FROM THE EDITOR

Next month I turn 55. Normally, getting older is not considered a good thing, but in this case I was able to contemplate one advantage. At 55 the qualifying time for the Boston Marathon goes up. I have had the good fortune to go to Boston several times and this year I hope that I can get in shape for a qualifying marathon this fall, or early winter. I've been logging a lot of miles this summer thinking that now I "only" have to run under 3:35, rather than the 3:30 standard for 50-54 year old men. My training and racing have been on track for achieving that goal, although nothing is certain until you actually run your race. A lot can go wrong running a marathon.

Well, can you believe it? Things have recently become somewhat easier for men and women over 45 hoping to qualify for Boston. In June, they changed the standards for older runners only. My standard is now up to 3:45. I got an extra 10 minutes! The changes give incrementally greater times as you get older. For instance, 45 year olds get 5 more minutes, 60 year olds have 20 minutes more, and, if you are lucky enough to be eighty and still able to run a marathon, you get an extra 70 minutes. I saw the announcement on runnersworld.com, and there is also a detailed summary at bostonmarathon.org. The field size limit has also been increased to 20,000. Qualifying times must be run by February 2, 2003 on a certified course. Older runners, check it out, and keep on running!

TEXAS SENIOR GAMES

The Texas State Senior Games will be held in Lubbock, August 26-September 1. The Games will include a 5K and 10K Road Race, Track and Field Events, a Triathlon, Cycling, Swimming, Racewalking, and many other athletic events. Competitors must be at least 50 before December 31, 2002 to be eligible. Additionally, you must have qualified at a regional event unless you live in the general West Texas area, defined as I-20 to the South, and the State line to the north. For more information call the Lubbock Sports Authority (806) 747-7572, or the Lubbock Senior Center, (806) 767-2710. Registration forms must be postmarked by August 10, 2002. This year's event is a qualifier for the National Senior Games, and registration is already well ahead of the total for last year's Senior Games.
