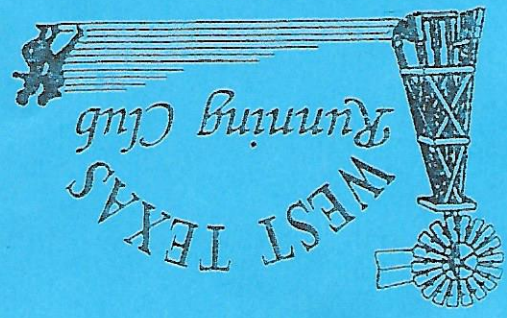

TURKEY TROT RACE REPORT

If the Club ever votes on the nicest day that a road race was run in Lubbock, this year's Turkey Trot will probably win. Just the right chill at the start, barely a whisper of wind all morning, clear skies, and a 2100 goose salute early in the race all blended together to give us an almost perfect race day.

This year we had 96 finishers in the 2-mile event and 105 in the 12K race. Bob Jackson, running on his 43 year old legs, came up from Hobbs, took overall honors, and set a new record for his age division. Similarly, Janda Ibbetson not only was the overall female finisher but also gave her age group a new best time. Six other age group records fell (beautiful conditions have a way of making this happen). For the men, Jarred Davis (15), Al Gardner (45), and Don Sanderson (72) set new standards for their respective divisions; for the women, Madonne Miner (49), Etta Mayer (52), and P.J. Mitchell (55) lowered the time-to-beat for their age groups.

Thanks to a great group of volunteers-too many to list here- the race went off quite smoothly. One final note of thanks to the runners themselves who came out and made this 9th running of the Turkey Trot one of the best events of the year. Your sweat and smiles make it all worth the effort.
