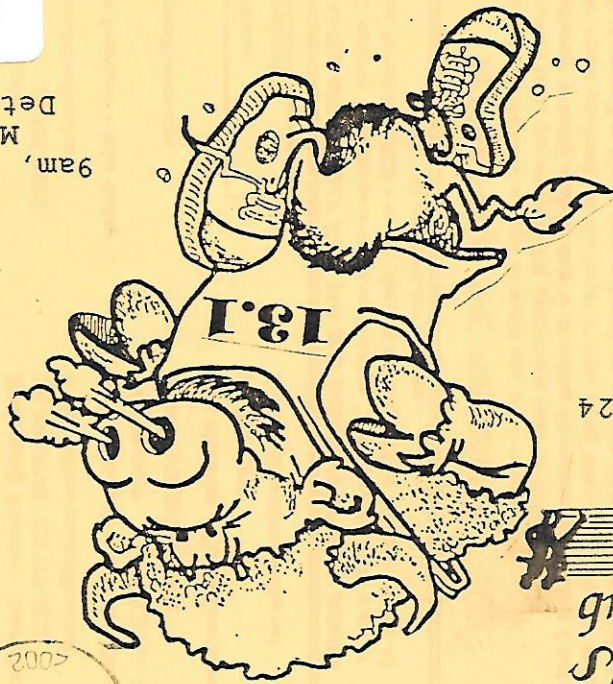

**IRONMAN WORLD CHAMPIONSHIPS-KONA, HAWAII**

Shanna Armstrong finished this year's Ironman World Championship in Kona in a time of 11:56:12, placing 6<sup>th</sup> in her age category. Lubbock resident and former club member Greg Hogan finished in 12:15:55. Congratulations to each on their great results!

**CROSS COUNTRY RESULTS**

The fastest runners in the Lubbock ISD Invitational Boy's race on September 28<sup>th</sup> at Mae Simmons Park were not 5A or 4A division runners. They were 3A high school runners (and members of the WTRC) Gary Lackey of Brownfield and Casey Sumpter of Iamesa. The two ran together until the last quarter of a mile when Gary pulled away to run the day's best time of 15:52. Casey logged a time of 15:55 in capturing second place. Club member Alyssa Preston finished 11<sup>th</sup> in the Girl's 4A race, in a time of 13:03. It should be noted that Alyssa is running for Frenship High School as a freshman. At District Championships, Gary Lackey won 2-3A with a time of 16:01 for the three mile course; Casey Sumpter (recovering from an injury) won the 3-3A meet in 18:22; Alyssa Preston finished 4<sup>th</sup> in District 4-4A in a time of 12:52 for two miles.
