**** The West Texas Running Club's Challenge Series ****

The WTRC CHALLENGE SERIES continues, as a 12 month series of 13 races culminating in year-end awards for performance, endurance and participation by club members in our monthly club races. The schedule of events is listed in the calendar of each newsletter, and each designated race will be detailed in the W.T.R.C. Newsletter prior to that race. Additional categories this year will again recognize non running volunteers.

All members desiring to participate in the Challenge Series must volunteer to serve as a non-running worker at one Challenge Series event as an entry requirement. (There will be no duplication of awards)

The Challenge Series features these categories:

1. **66 Mile Club **** All members completing 66 miles in qualifying events will receive an award denoting that achievement. There will be a total of approximately 101 qualifying miles available. Any member serving as RACE DIRECTOR will be credited with double mileage for the most miles in that event. Any member who serves as a volunteer will be credited for the most miles at those races with more than one distance.
2. **MILEAGE AWARD **** An award will be presented to the male and female members who accumulate the most miles for the year in qualifying events. All provisions for Race Directors and volunteers listed above apply to this category.
3. **PARTICIPATION AWARD ***** An award will be presented to the female and male members who participate in the greatest number of qualifying events. All provisions for Race Directors and volunteers apply to this category.
4. **VOLUNTEER OF THE YEAR **** Up to three awards will be given to those non runners who help the most at club sanctioned events. These selections will be made by the Race Directors.
5. **VICTOR'S RANKINGS ***** Points will be earned at each qualifying event in the following Age and Sex groupings:
 - A. Divisions will include: **MALE AGE GROUPS:** 0-12, 13-15, 16-19, 20-24, 25-29, 30-34, 35-39 40-44, 45-49, 50-54, 55-59, 60-64, 65-69 & 70+
 - FEMALE AGE GROUPS:** 0-12, 13-15, 16-19, 20-24, 25-29, 30-34, 35-39, 40-44, 45-49, 50-54, 55-59 & 60 Plus.

(those less than 13 must run in the shortest races offered)

Clydesdale/Athena category: Men over 190 pounds, Women over 150 pounds

Age Graded Scoring.

B. The overall winners in each race are awarded 11 points, then the 1st place finisher in each division at each distance at each qualifying event will earn 10 points, the 2nd place, 9 points, 3rd place, 8 points, and so on down to 1 point for 10th place finisher. This rewards both performance and participation, i.e., if a runner finishes last in their division, but only 3 other runners in that division attend that race, the last place finisher would still earn 7 points for a 4th place finish. This allows slower runners who attend more races to accumulate additional points over their faster competitors who do not participate as often. For example, a runner who attends 10 events and earns 6 points at each would have more points than a competitor who won each of 5 events he entered, thus rewarding participation and performance. Also, runners may enter any distance available at a qualifying event and still earn points. (Except those under 13 years of age must run in the shortest race)
- C. Awards will be presented to a minimum of 3 and up to 5 of the top point scorers in each division. Awards will be presented at a year end membership meeting.
- D. To win a "Points" award a member must have run in at least 3 events and volunteered for at least one other.
- E. Monthly Challenge Series Statistical Updates will appear in the Newsletter.

MASTER RUNNERS

Current master runner, Bob Jackson, is slowly but steadily eating up all previous age division standards but has been slowed this year by having had foot surgery in January after setting a new standard in the M45-49 LOOP THE LAKE 5 MILE. Before Bob resumed his running career in the area, George Jury had a stint of about 11 years in which he set new age standards. After beginning to run in WTRC races in 1978 at age 41 he reached his peak at age 49 and ran pretty well until age 56, when in 1992 he was diagnosed with Crohn's disease which caused bizarre muscle, joint and bursa ailments and curtailed his running. Then while riding his bicycle in June 1997, he was hit from behind by the wheel of a trailer pulled behind a slow moving car resulting in a severe muscle injury on the left Achilles/calf muscle area, then later it was discovered to have damaged both knees. After 2 surgeries on the left knee he has been unable to run since. Most of you know George from his volunteer endeavors at our races, but he was recognized at the 33rd Annual BUFFALO WALLOW RACES for having served as Race Director for 15 years. On the back of the T Shirts presented to Half Marathon finishers were most of his event records. Below are all the records he has held, some for 20 years now and three he has lost.

A Runner's Notes
Jim Harris

In the last two months, I had the good luck to run in some incredibly beautiful places. I ran by the bay in San Francisco, on a mesa in Albuquerque, along forest trails at Austin's Town Lake, and on the beach in Galveston.

In addition, of course, I ran the three WTRC club races in November and December, the GWJ Buffalo Wallows, the Turkey Trot, and the Red Line, each presenting different terrains.

For a runner, diverse landscapes offer unique challenges to test conditioning, and they offer bountiful opportunities to enjoy being outside in natural and manmade settings. After running these very different locales and a mountain trail run north of Monterrey, California, I think I've decided that I prefer flatland running on short, paved courses.

But I've also decided that what I enjoy most about running is just being out under the big sky. We live domed lives these days, hurrying from house to automobile to office during the week, while shuffling from mall to theater to restaurant on the weekends.

I like what Texas writer Rick Bass says about how walking through a natural landscape affords us the opportunity to realize "our ancient attachment to the land and an older and more enduring world of stone and sky, antler and bone and feather...."

Bass writes that we need to toil our land to solidify our attachment to it. I like that word "toil." I associate it with work, something I enjoy and feel is essential to good health. In fact, that's another idea my recent runs have reinforced for me. It is the idea that work trumps idleness, even in edenic settings that tempt us to lie back and spend the day eating an apple. For me, there's a good possibility I won't enjoy the apple if I haven't worked some before the eating.

Back in the 1830s, an adventurer named Josiah Gregg hiked across the plains of West Texas and Eastern New Mexico and wrote of his experiences in a book called "Commerce of the Prairies," first published in 1844. He thought the Llano Estacado "constituted a kind of chaotic space where nature seemed to have indulged in her wildest caprices."

Sometimes when I'm running my favorite flat road courses on the Southern Plains, I think of Gregg's "chaotic space" and know this is where I want to be. I'd

like to have traveled through the prairie wilderness before the ranchers, settlers, and pioneers divided it up in the latter years of the 19th century, but in many ways the land still offers us a natural beauty many folks of the world only dream about, a beauty that can be seen even in certain Lubbock parks.

I realize that in the big picture, it doesn't really matter where we are, so long as we are healthy and working, but this corner of the American Southwest is my home and I am thankful that I get to run here.

For a runner, a moment of gratitude might be one reason to slow down and let the engine idle. With life's race so short, it can't hurt to be thankful.
