NOTES FROM THE PRESIDENT

Unless you happened to read about it in a recent newsletter or tried to register on race day this summer, you may not even be aware of our recent changes in race entry fees. For all of you who take the time to register, either online, by mail, phone, e-mail, or personal delivery, the base cost of a member's entry is still only \$5; and non-members now pay \$10 instead of \$6. But if you wait (as I did for the Hot Dam) you get to pay \$15 ... same as anyone else who walks up on race day.

The Board had two major objectives in mind when it enacted these changes. One was to make membership worth the money ... a paltry \$1 difference between member and non-member registration just was not worth the trouble of joining. As I tried to say in earlier articles, we need a strong membership base to keep this club vital 10, 20, 30 years from now.

The other objective was the growing concern that we are simply burning out that very small handful of volunteers who are willing to run our timing computers. Our hope is that the penalty price of late registration discourages walk-ups, thereby making the pressure on our computer staff a bit lighter. Yet simply making their job easier will only delay their burn out. We need new blood to stand in for them ... and our cries for help have not been answered. Understandably, runners would rather run. I have to agree that I find running a lot more fun than learning how to operate our Runscore program.

At the Hot Dam I was approached by a Club member (who insisted on anonymity) with the following proposal. He will donate \$600 to what he called the "Let Tom Griffin Run Again Fund", such money being earmarked to train and handsomely pay a non-member to time half of our races. His argument was that such money was not political (subject to a vote on spending the Club's money) and that we should be able to get right on the search and training process.

Well Tom, George and David will have to do the training, but it will be up to the rest of us to join in the search. There are enough geeks out there who COULD do the job, but we must hunt for those one or two who WILL take us seriously and be dependable on the weekends we run our events.

I am assuming that the money will come as promised and that the Board will approve giving it a try. If so, I want to start begging now ... please, please, please let Tom Griffin run again!!! Find that geek for us ASAP.
