Dear WTRC Members:

As the new keeper of the Challenge Series scoring I would like to encourage all of our members to participate in this fun, informative and motivational part of the Club's races. In addition, I'd like to briefly describe the two Programs that comprise the series and make you aware of some changes to the scoring systems that the board has approved.

The first Program is the 66 mile challenge. To achieve recognition in this part of the program an individual needs to run in and volunteer for races summing to 66 or more miles. Volunteering is an important aspect of this activity and many of our club members volunteer at several races on their way to earning this recognition. Each club member that achieves the 66 mile requirement (combined running and service) receives a long-sleeve shirt at the annual banquet held in January.

The second part of the Challenge Series is the age group classifications, Athena and Clydesdale competitions. Many of our members use this part of the series to gauge the progress in their training regime and motivate themselves to get out and train a little harder. The Challenge Series requires members to volunteer for at least one race and run three others.

In 2008 the WTRC Board has made some changes to Series rules to correct an issue in the scoring. In previous years, when a member moved from one age group to another they took the points earned with them to the new group. By 'exporting points' from one age group to another it is possible for a runner who consistently finished behind another competitor to accrue more points in the age-group point standings. While this is a relatively rare occurrence, the ripple effect invariably affects four or five members. In the group where the runner departs, members are artificially advanced. In the group the runner enters runners are systematically moved back.

In order to correct the scoring aberration, the WTRC Board has made two changes to the Challenge Series and Race Day Scoring rules. The WTRC Board realizes that there is a potential incongruence in the two scoring rules. However, the current timing system used to manage race day activities does not possess the capability to 're-classify' runners in accordance with Rule 1. A similar problem exists with the Athena and Clydesdale winners having to be removed from the age-grouped classifications for awards purposes. Therefore the WTRC is making the following change to the Challenge Series Scoring.

New Challenge Series and Race Day Scoring Rules

- 1. Challenge Series year-end division standings will be determined by the runner's age at the mid-point of the calendar year (June 30th). Runners born in the first half of the year will be moved into the older age-grade classification when the majority of the year is spent in the next grouping. For example, a runner born April 18th and turning 40 years old will compete in the 40-44 age-group classification since they will spend the majority of the year at that age. A runner born November 13th and turning 40 will remain in the 35-39 age group for the point series scored in that year (they were 39 for 11.5 months). The aim of this rule is to have the same group of runners competing head-to-head for the entire year.
- 2. For each race, the runner's age-group division will be determined by their age on race day.

The WTRC is committed to accurately compiling, calculating, and recognizing the achievements and contributions of those who participate in our events. 

Doctors and coaches agree that kids should not start running in any purposeful way before they start kindergarten. That's because most children won't achieve a mature running gait until they are at least 5 years old. Duke University pediatric cardiologist Brenda Armstrong, M.D., who helps coach the Durham Striders youth track club for ages 6 and up, in North Carolina, says her biggest concern at this age is injuries. "I worry about shinsplints in a very young child whose gait is not yet coordinated," says Dr. Armstrong. Also, 3 and 4-year-olds have short attention spans, and their vision is not yet mature, making it difficult for them to track and judge the speed of moving objects.

A young child should still run as part of play and can try short children's races of up to a couple hundred yards. "As long as the child is capable of running without falling down, it's okay to run in brief spurts," says Teri McCambridge, M.D., a pediatric sports-medicine specialist. "If the parents do a 5-K race, a child can do the 'kiddie dash."

AGES 5 - 8

Youngsters 5 to 8 years old should be encouraged to run as part of play, such as in games of tag, or in short bursts with walking or other activities in between. Running in this way allows children to use more of their body than if they were jogging continually in a straight path, which makes it less likely that they'll become bored or injured.

Longtime coach Bob Glover, who conducts the City Sports for Kids track program for the New York Road Runners Foundation, has his youngest charges, 5 to 8, work up to 20 or 30 minutes of movement, running, or walking three times a week. While running a couple of 200-meter laps, they play games like hiding behind the coach, and Glover takes frequent breaks to read running-related stories to the kids. "Most of the kids are having so much fun, they don't even know they're running," says Glover.

In the Durham Striders club, 6- to 8-year-olds do a few 100-meter repeats on the curve of the track or the grass infield. "The 6-year-olds can run or walk," says Frank Davis, one of the club's founders. Other days, Durham kids run hills, repeating bursts on a 50- to 75-meter incline.

Many experts, however, warn against 5-Ks for those under 8. "We're fine with a mile fun run, but nothing longer," says Brenda Armstrong, M.D., of Duke. "And a child who says he or she is hurting or tired must be allowed to stop." Bill Roberts, M.D., past president of the American College of Sports Medicine, has his own Happy Test. He believes that 7- or 8-year-olds can run a couple of miles, provided it's their choice and they enjoy it. How can you tell? "Smiles," he says.

West Texas Running Club/Texas Tech University Scholarship

West Texas Running Club is pleased to announce the West Texas Running Club/Texas Tech University Scholarship. Applicants must have a letter of nomination from a WTRC member, complete and submit a standardized application form and attend Texas Tech University. Preference will be given to undergraduate students who are permanent residents of West Texas as defined: the area north of Interstate 20 as far West as Pecos and to west of a line from Abilene to Wichita Falls. Preference will also be given to full-time students (minimum 12 credit hours) at who have completed at least one semester. Stipends of up to \$500 per semester will be awarded based on the following criteria: participation in extracurricular activities, participation in school activities, leadership positions held, academic record and financial need. Special consideration is given to candidates who participate in activities that are consistent with the goals of the club. It is expected that recipients of this scholarship either run in or volunteer at West Texas Running Club races, although exceptions can be made in extenuating circumstances. Scholarship applications are due on May 1, 2008. In the event that funds are still available after the initial awards have been made, late applications will be considered.




