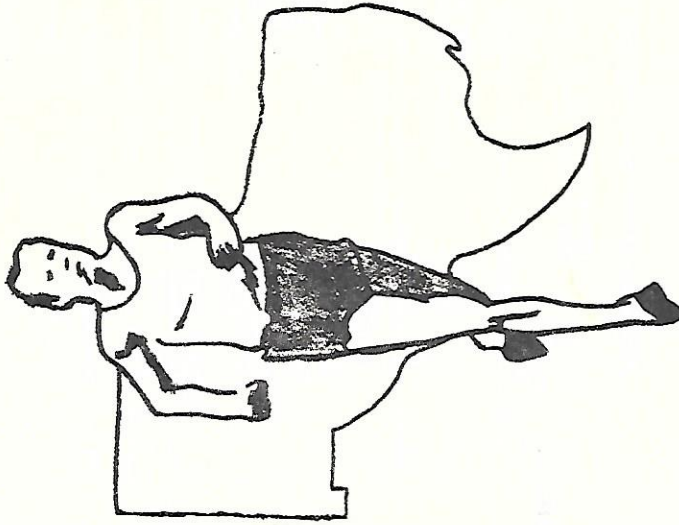

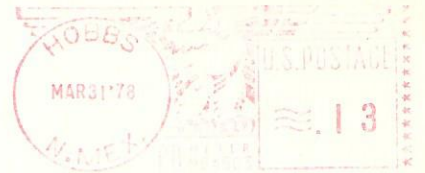

4 MILE RUN, HODGES PARK, LUBBOCK, TEXAS, MARCH 11, 1978

A total of 57 runners gathered in Hodges Park to trample the grass and vie with each other on an equal performance level in the Third Annual Handicap Run. The above total included 37 Handicap runners. The winner of the Handicap race was a faithful club runner, Ed Veron of Snyder, who started out eighth with a 7:48 deficit. Jim Hogan was the winner in the Non-handicap portion of the race in a time of 23:14. The day's fastest time, however, was turned in by Cliff McCurdy who left a trail of scorched grass in his wake as he came home in 21:50. Cliff was the next-to-last starter with a 19:58 deficit, and still managed to pass enough people to come in eighth. Sarah Lamont had the distinction of being the second female in the history of the club to win the handicap award.

NEWS FROM JACK PETTY

Only one record fell due to the heat of 80 degrees and more during the 2nd Annual STFF-sanctioned event of the One Hour Run sponsored by the West Texas Running Club at the Odessa High School track Saturday.

Caylene Cadell, a 26 year old Texas Tech female athlete, broke Reenie Smith's old record in the Ladies Open of 7 1/4 miles with just over 8 miles. Second was Caro Tylka an OHS junior, with 7 1/4 miles, also bettering the old mark. Reenie Smith placed 3rd this year as the Bowie Jr. high aerobics instructor complete 7 1/4 miles plus 160 yars. Debra Dozier of Odessa placed 4th.

Fred Stricklin, a Midland, Texas coach, won overall and took the open division with 9 1/4 miles and 100 yards. This was well off of Jack Petty's overall record of 10 3/4 miles. Jimmy Whitley, last year's open winner with 10 1/4 miles was second with 9 1/4 miles and 220 yards. Third was Rick Ricketts while other Odessans included Charles McGowan 4th, Robert Gonzales 5th, Bobby Nelson 6th, Tom Payne 8th, Cory Crumrine 9th, Jay Murdock 10th, Dan Pulatti 11th, and Chuck Smith 12th.

The 30-29 results were Norman Smith of Midland the new champ after running 2nd last year. Smith covered 9 3/4 miles and 130 yards. 2nd was Bob Russell of Hobbs, and 3rd was Rick Farias of Midland. Other places were Jack Petty (Odessa) 7th.

Howard Millsap of Odessa finished 2nd with 9 miles and 35 yards, as Bob Dunbar from Amarillo repeated as Champion again in the 40-49 age division race. Chuck McKnight of Lubbock ran 3rd. Dunbar completed 9 1/2 miles plus 150 yards.

J.E. Alexander of McCamey took the Master's II Division (ages 50-over) with a fine exact 8 miles. "Swoose" is better known as an American record holder for 400 yards at his age division running sub 60 seconds 440's. He's 58 years of age.

Donna Dozier took the Ladies Novice first place trophy with 6 1/4 miles and 40 yards, (from Odessa.)

Second went to Arlene Ragan, an Ector High School teacher, with 6 miles 160 yards. Third was Sheila Bell of Odessa with 5 3/4 miles.

The age 17-under "Young Novice" class was won by Ricky Rodriguez in 8 1/2 miles and 161 yards. Second place was Odessa Johnny Herrera only 1 yard back. Matthew Blackman of Odessa took 3rd place trophy.

All runners received commemorative T-shirts and some lucky winners took away certificates for merchandise donated by local merchants.
