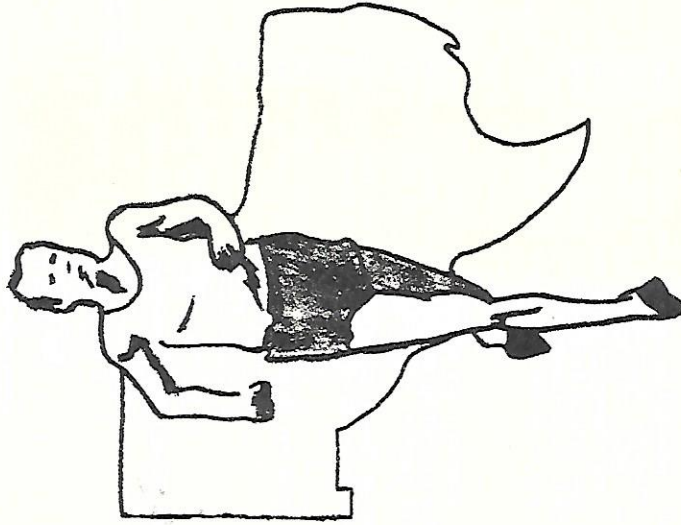

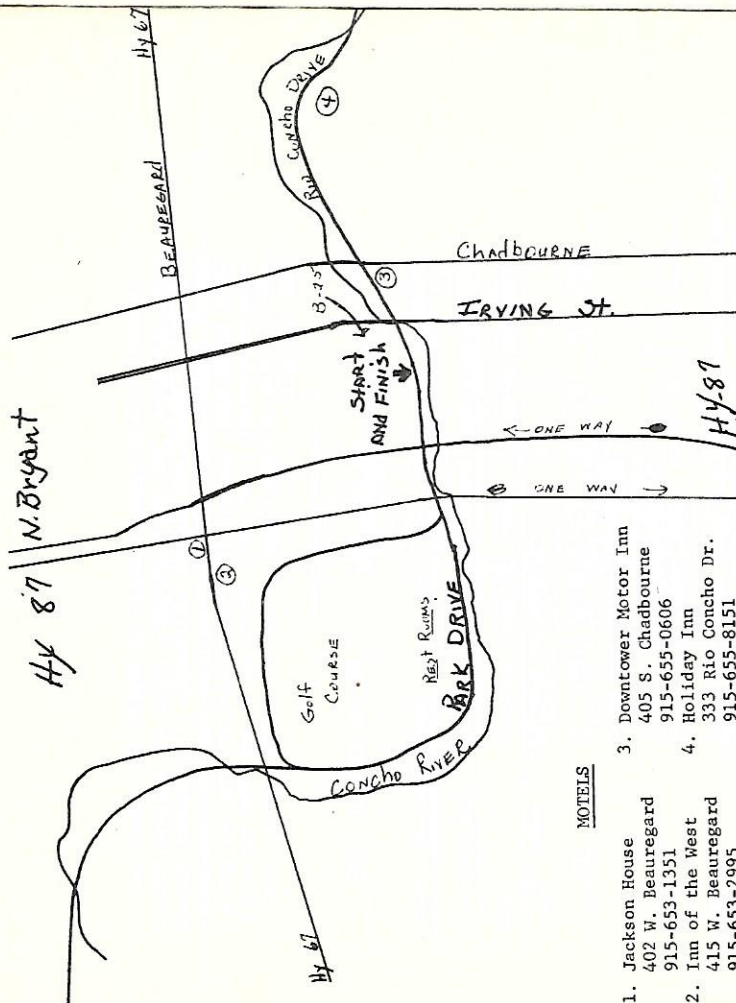

:: New Age Group Record

12 Mile and 2 Mile Race - Saturday May 13, 1978 9:00 a.m. Horseshoe Bend Canyon, Slaton, Texas. Clear, calm (no measurable wind) 60 F., 41% humidity.

A large field of 100 runners was treated to one of the most perfect days for racing (weatherwise) that we have ever had in West Texas. It was certainly a change from most past Horseshoe Bend Canyon 12 milers, when the wind was usually howling. This May's race was run in almost a dead calm and with pleasant temperatures.

The 12 mile race was unusual in that the overall winner did not come from the open group as is usually the case. Thirty nine year old Tom Mayfield showed the younger folks how it's done as he raced home to an easy victory. But there, Tom is a very unusual runner. Rumer has it that he changes in a phone booth before the races. Tom's winning time of 69:23 was also a new 30-39 age group record.

Unbelievably, after running 12 miles, the contest for second and third overall turned into a real horserace all the way to the finish line as J.J. Jenkins out-duelled Jack McQuinn by one second, despite an outstanding final mile by Jack.

Dale Thompson and Bob Dunbar, the dynamic duo from Amarillo, ran virtually together for the entire race, but Dale was able to pull away in the last 2 miles and post a 38 second win. His time of 72:05 was good for a new 40-49 record as he broke Bob's old mark by 2:50. Bob also came in under the old record. Also interesting was the fact that three of the top six finishers were 39 or older.

The two mile also saw some outstanding performances, Cliff McCurdy's overall winning time of 9:40 was good enough to tie Marc Johnson's course record. Gary Schovajsa's winning time of 10:31 in the 30-39 age group broke the old 30 and over record of 10:46 held by Jasper Peoples. However, since this was the first time that we had a 30-39 division in the two mile, Gary's time will be carried as a 30-39 age group record and Jasper's time will still stand as a 40 and over age group record.

Four members of the Whitten family competed in the May races (two won awards). I don't believe we have ever had this many representatives from one family running at the same time before.
