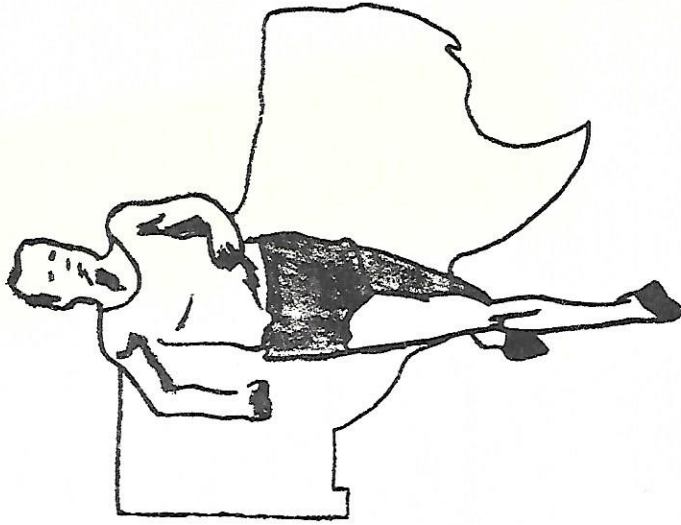

On a cool, windless day that favored fast times, John Bednarski sped to a new nine mile course record as he won easily in 47:32. His time knocked more as he won easily in 47:32. His time knocked more than two minutes off of the old mark of 49:46. Tom Mayfield, who was getting his last chance at this course as a 30-39 year old, set a new record for that age group as his time of 51:45 broke the old record by one second! Swoose Alexander knocked 3:30 off of the 50 & Over mark with a fine time of 63:48.

The two mile had not been run here previously, so all times turned in are now course records. It may be some time before anyone breaks the mark that Isabel Navarro turned in in the girls division. Her time of 11:47 was good for a fifth place finish overall.

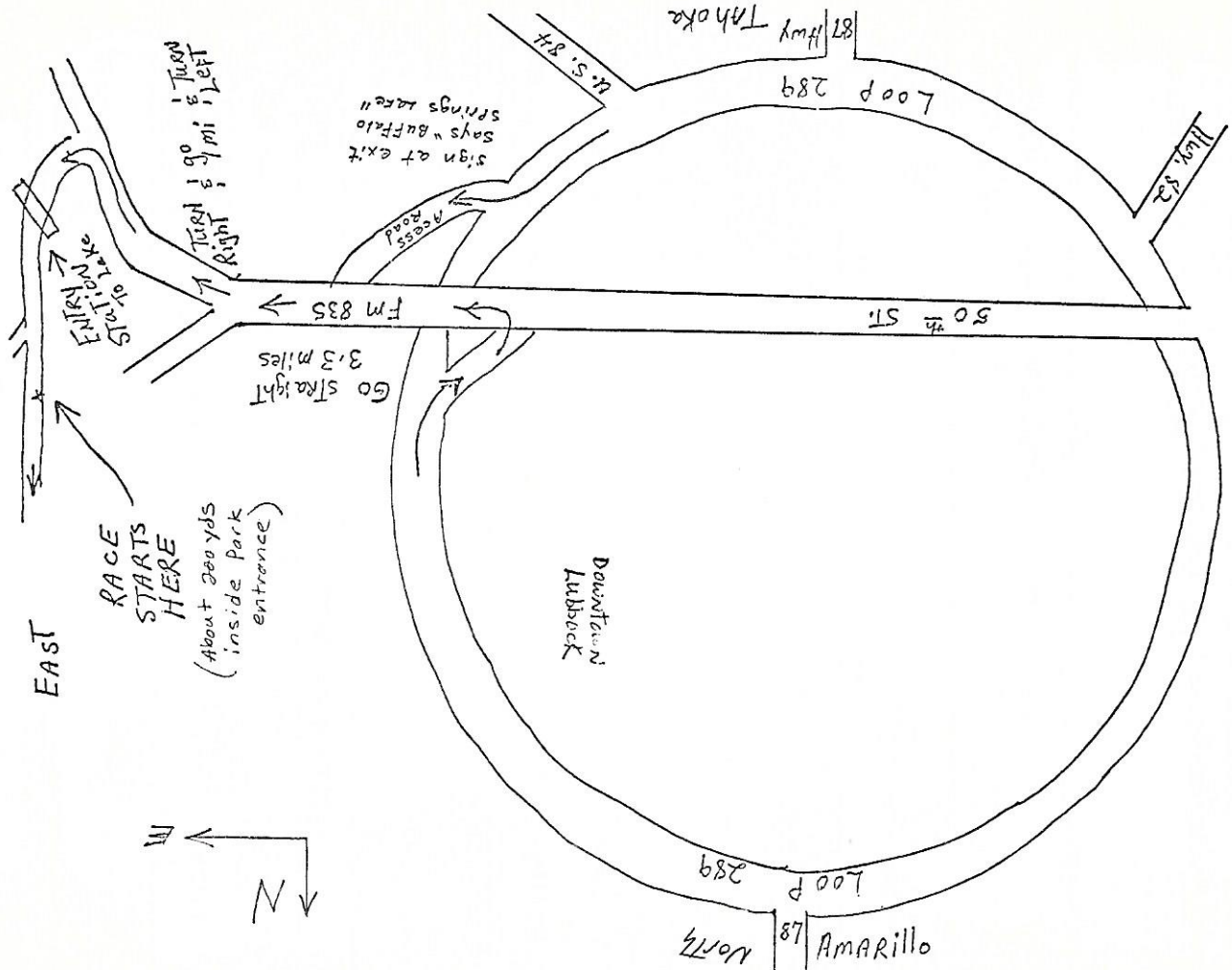
