SEVENTH ANNUAL "COTTON PATCH" RUN

Saturday, February 10, 1979 10:00 A.M.
 Temp 44° Humidity 53%

Tony Lozano led a field of 61 finishers as he sped to victory in the eight mile on an almost perfect day for running. Tony's time of 42:15 missed a course record by a heart breaking one second. The results literally sparkled with outstanding times in both events as records fell in profusion.

Jack Petty, who is now running hard again, tumbled Tom Mayfield's 30-39 record, and now that Tom has moved into the 40-49 age group he can't recapture this one. Tom, on the other hand, running his first club race as a 40 year old, blasted 3:41 off of a 40-49 record that had stood since 1974. It looks like Tom has set his sights on rewriting the 40-49 record book. Dan Webb of Coahoma also broke a 50 and over record that had stood since 1974, however, Warren Brown still holds the club member's record.

Cliff McCurdy sacked up first place in the three mile, and although he missed an overall course record, he did manage to lower his own club member's record by 45 seconds. Rudy Garcia and Robert Schooler set new records in the High School and 15 and under divisions respectively, while Joe Tighe and Isabel Navarro set new marks in the 30-39 and Girls divisions. Isabel's time of 17:47 represented a performance level of 535, which is the highest ever recorded by a female runner in a club race. Also noteworthy was eight year old Brian Bishop's 21:22 in the three mile. Five year old James E. Whitten also managed to finish the three mile as he logged a 39:07.

For the third time ever, the handicap award was won by a female runner as Sarah Lamont ran 6:14 under her handicap time. This marks the second time that Sarah has won the award.

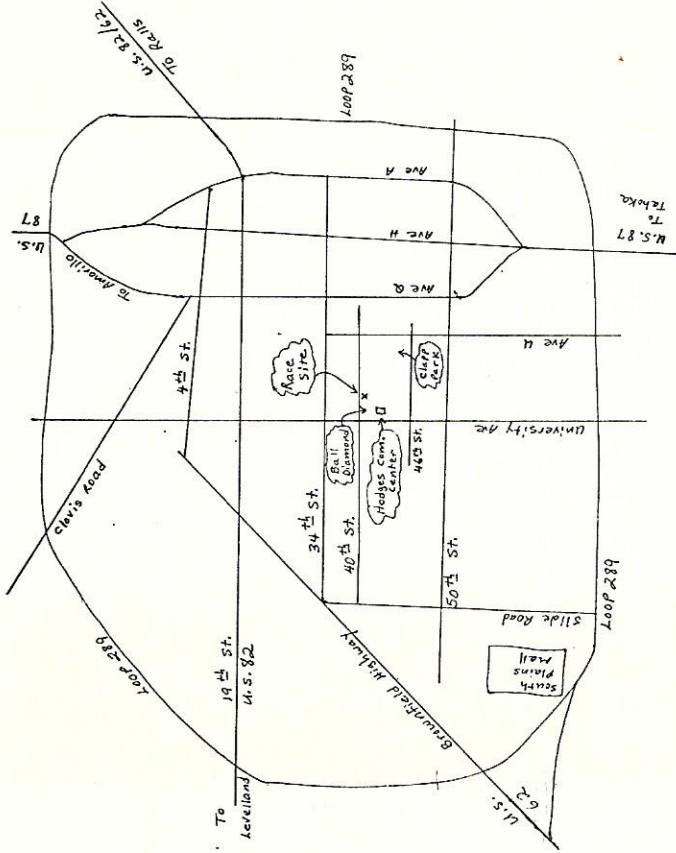
