HORSESHOE BEND CANYON 12 MILE AND 2 MILE RUNS
(Saturday May 12, 1979, 9:00 a.m., clear, 60°
54% Humidity, Wind 8 MPH from the south)

The 12 mile race was a study in contrasts. The winner was Robert Schooler, who was the youngest runner in the race, while the second place runner was Dale Thompson, who is Robert's senior by 28 years. This, by the way, is one of the outstanding benefits of the West Texas Running Club to High School level runners. They are able to run against competition of all classes and experience levels and cannot help but improve as a result.

Robert's time of 1:08:28 represented a performance level of 722.9, which is his best race in his two years as a club member. Dale is also to be commended for setting a new 40-49 group standard. Tom Bowser did the same in the 50 & over division. New member Sherill Easterling finished the 12 in 1:36:19 (1st place Ladies Division) like it was a stroll in the park, and continued running past the finish line, down the road, and out of sight. Apparently she was really into it and didn't want to quit while she was having fun.

The two mile saw a smoking duel between John Bednarski and Cliff McCurdy. Cliff made up about 30 yards near the end, but fell one second short of overtaking John. Their respective times of 9:32 and 9:33 were both under the old course record. This was an outstanding day for female runners as records fell in both the Ladies and Girls Divisions. Brenda Barrett took the new Ladies Honors while Mindee Mayfield and Carol Tylka staged their own duel as they finished in a virtual dead heat. Mindee was judged to be an eyelash ahead as both girls were clocked in a super time of 12:29.

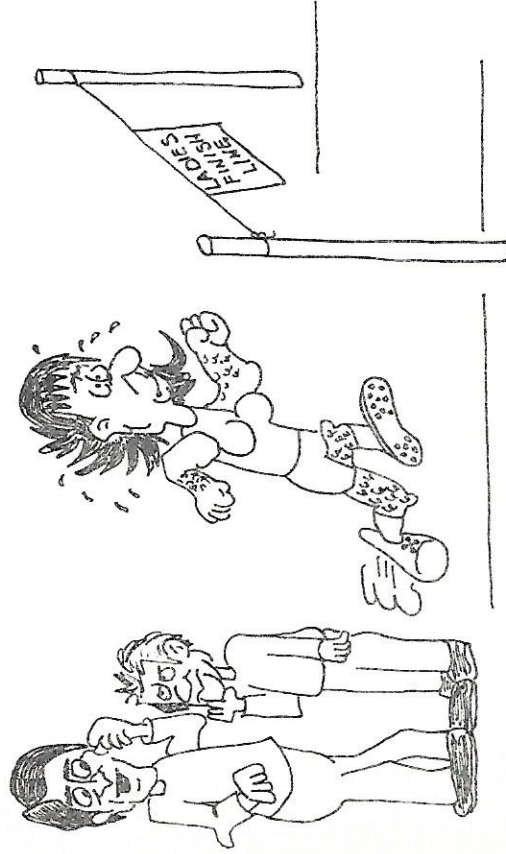

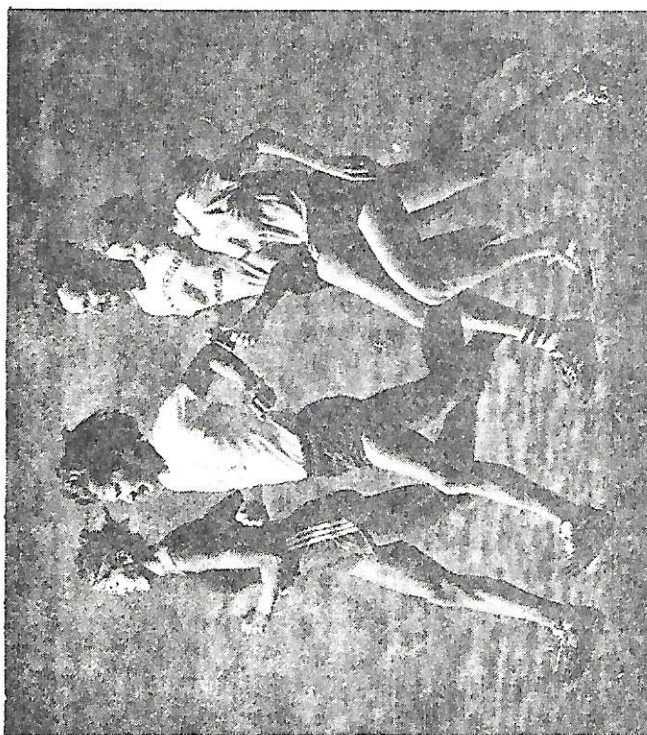
