AMARILLO 5 MILE, 2 MILE SATURDAY, APRIL 12, 1980
320, Cloudy, Winds 25-40 MPH

70 people braved cold, windy weather to run in the 1980 Amarillo 5 Mile. Cliff McCurdy took the lead at the mile mark and gradually pulled away to win in 27:13. Jim Hogan came across second overall to win the 30-39 division in a record 28:30. The third finisher was Bobby Cunningham who claimed first place among 40-49 runners. He established a new division record of 29:03. Another record setter was Don Sanderson in the 50 & Over division. His 32:01 took nearly 3 minutes off the old record. The first ladies' finisher was Beverly Watkins. Her time of 33:51 was about 2 minutes under her own record from last year.

Several other people ran good races despite a stiff headwind the last 2 miles. Bobby Birdsong ran a PR 33:42, 2 minutes under his old best for 5 miles. This was despite arriving just 10 minutes before starting time due to snow on the highways outside Levelland. Jeff Roche, a high schooler from Canyon, ran a quick 29:07, and Bob Dunbar finished strong in 29:22. This was 1:31 under his 1979 time.

In the 2 Mile, 11 year old Keith Parr was the first boy across. The first girls' finisher was 13 year old Brenda Moore.

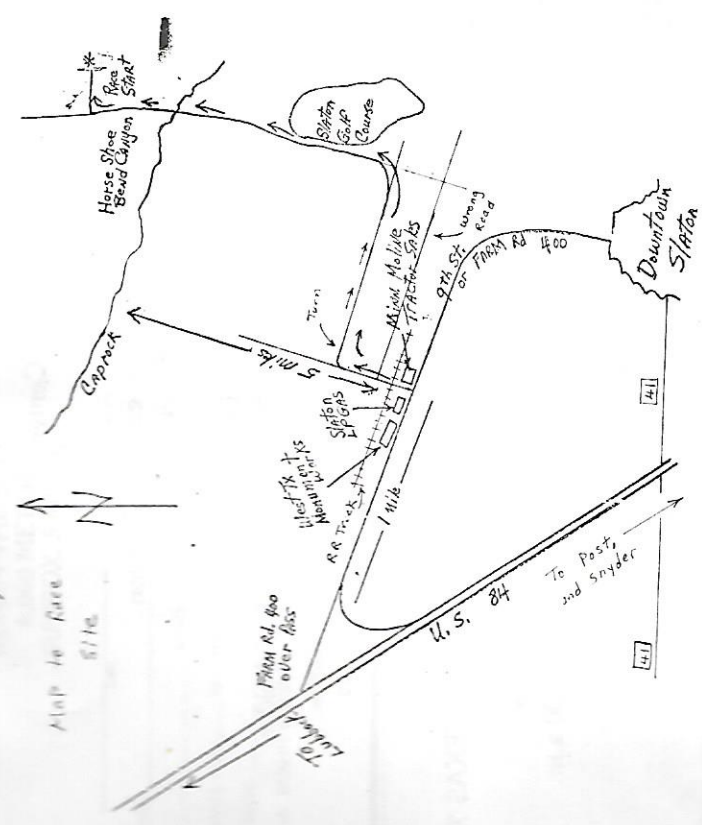

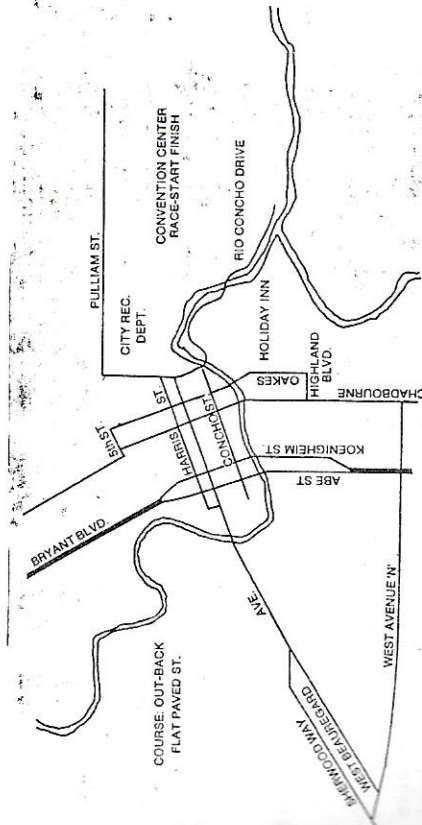

JASPER PEEPLES

Open any book of athletic records and you probably won't find Jasper Peeples listed, but ask any roadracer in the Panhandle of Texas and they will tell you about Jasper.

Jasper ran before the world and the United States discovered distance running and jogging. His avocation as a runner began in 1967. During the thirteen years after that beginning, he set his own personal records. At one point he decided to run each day for 1,000 days. Unfortunately, sickness cut him short at 951 days.

Between 1975 and 1979, Jasper consistently averaged in excess of 1,000 miles per year with a top of 2,162 miles in 1975. These achievements, among others, were all completed despite his thriving dental practice.

In 1975 Jasper became a member of The West Texas Track Club. He often placed in the top three in races scheduled by the Club and in other competitions. In the 1978 Dental Olyffice (Anaheim, California) he won first in the six-mile race, second in the two-mile run and third in the mile run. In the 1979 Dental Olympics (Dallas, Texas) he tried his hand at sprint distances placing first in the 440 and 880 and placed second in the six and two mile races.

In 1975 Jasper, like all roadracers, decided he had to run at Boston in 1978. He began training in earnest in the Summer of 1975 by taking a practice run from Dumas, Texas down Highway 152 toward Stinnett, Texas. Little did he know then that this run in the heat of the Texas sun would prepare him for the hottest day Boston had ever seen for their classic marathon.

To get to Boston he had to meet time qualifications in another marathon and in September of 1975 he placed fourth at Odessa, Texas, with a time of 3 hours 20 minutes to qualify for Boston. In April, 1976 he ran the Boston Marathon in 3 hours 45 minutes in a marathoner's nightmare of heat.

Jasper ran through 1979 and the first part of 1980. On January 23, 1980, at the age of 44, Jasper Peeples died of complications after removal of a brain tumor. This race is dedicated to his memory.

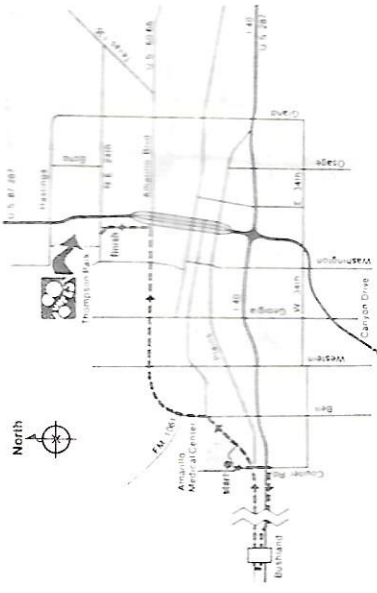
