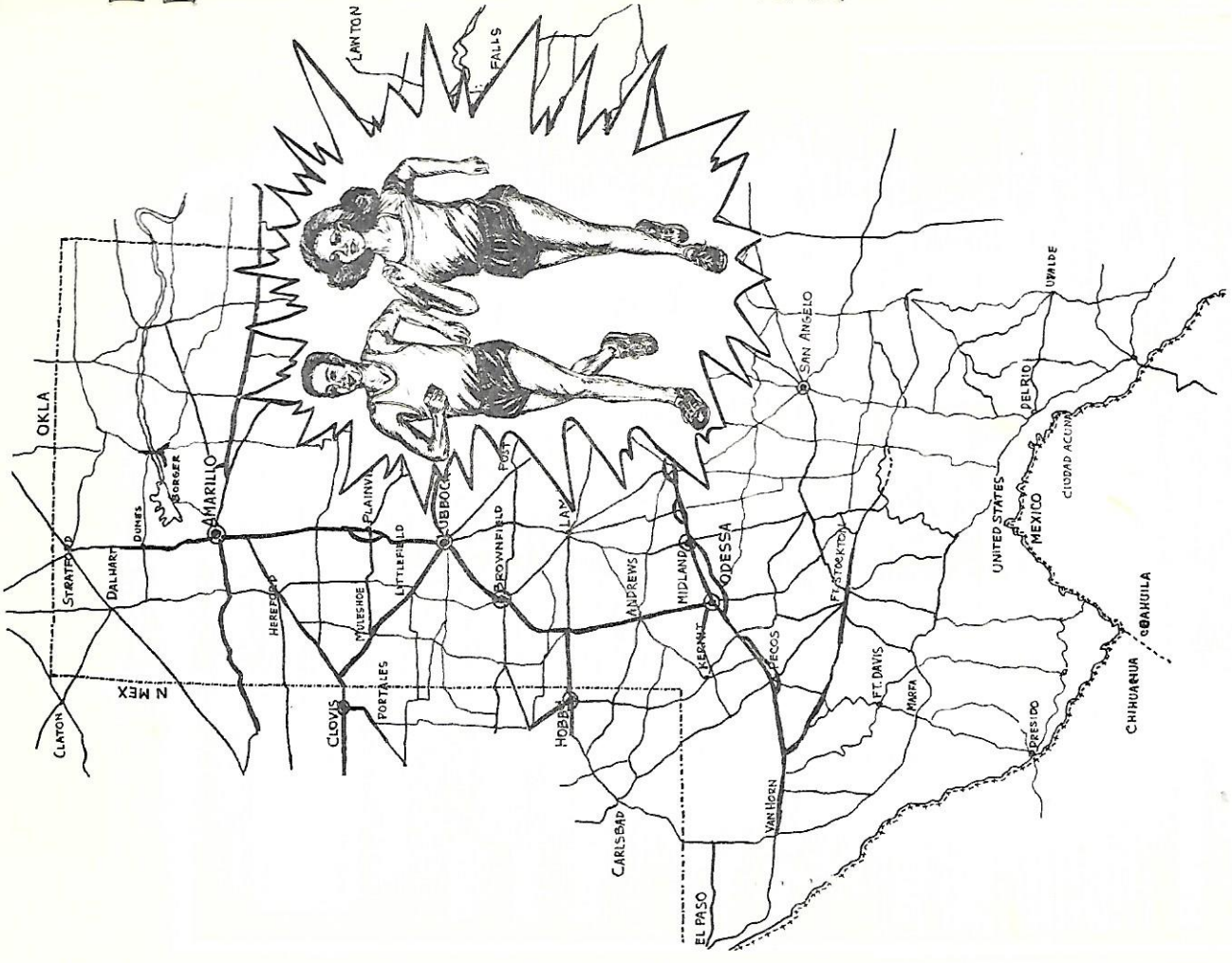

- HORSESHOE BEND CANYON 12 MILE AND 2 MILE RUNS
Saturday, May 10, 1980, 9:00 AM
Temperature: 64° F Humidity: 68% Wind: From SW at 14 MPH
- Records fell in both the two mile and twelve mile club runs held in picturesque but windy Horseshoe Bend Canyon. Carlos Ybarra of Lamesa out-legged Buddy Hutto of Clovis by eight seconds to win the two mile run in 9:59. His time eclipses the old boys high school division record held by Dickey Patterson of Borger by eight seconds. Elizabeth Holguin captured the girl's division in 13:53 while Pat Dolan of Lubbock set a new ladies record of 14:09.
- While a strong wind astern boosted the twelve milers up the long hill at the one mile mark, the forty-one hearty participants were required to tack against an increasing head wind for the last six miles of the race. Despite this, two records were broken and several PR's were established. Cliff McCurdy finished alone in a time of 1:08:33. Robert Schooler of Midland, while not challenging his record high school division time set last year, still ran a strong race and finished second. John Bednarski from Odessa captured the 30-39 age group division in 1:11:46, and the Abernathy flash Bobby Cunningham cruised home in 1:15:11 to take honors in the 40-49 age category.

Don Sanderson established a new standard in the 50 & Over category with an outstanding 1:21:54 time. Coahoma's Sherril Easterling, fresh off a 3:09 timing for the Marathon of the Great Southwest, set a new mark in the ladies division with a 1:30:54.

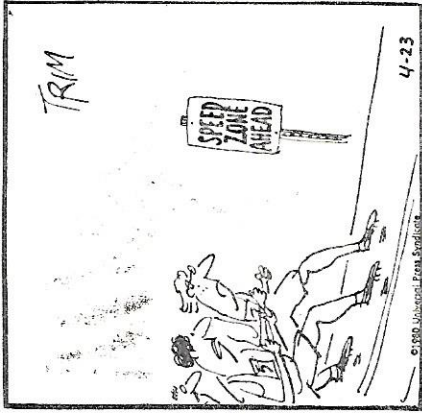
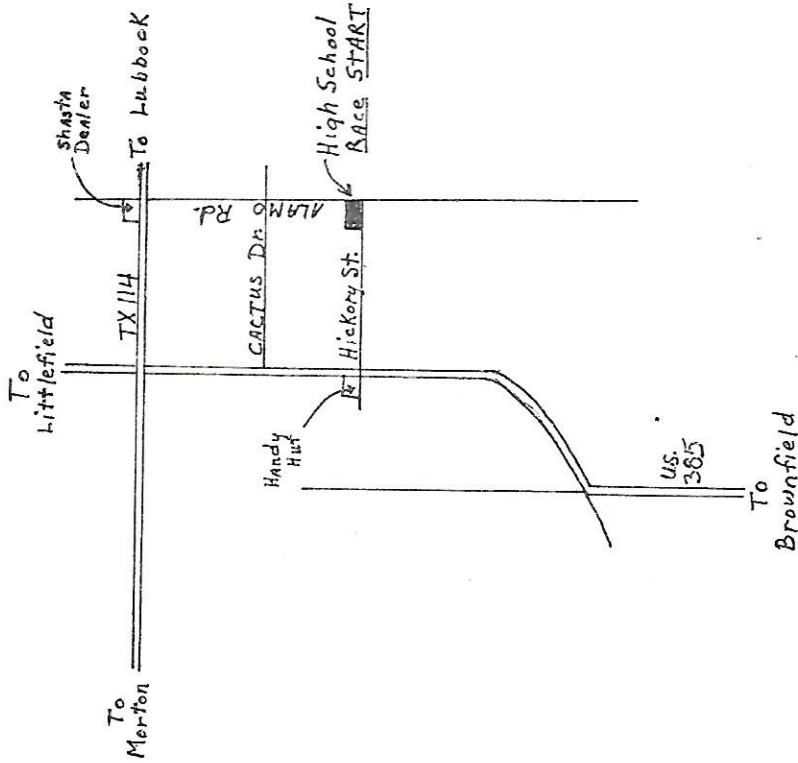
