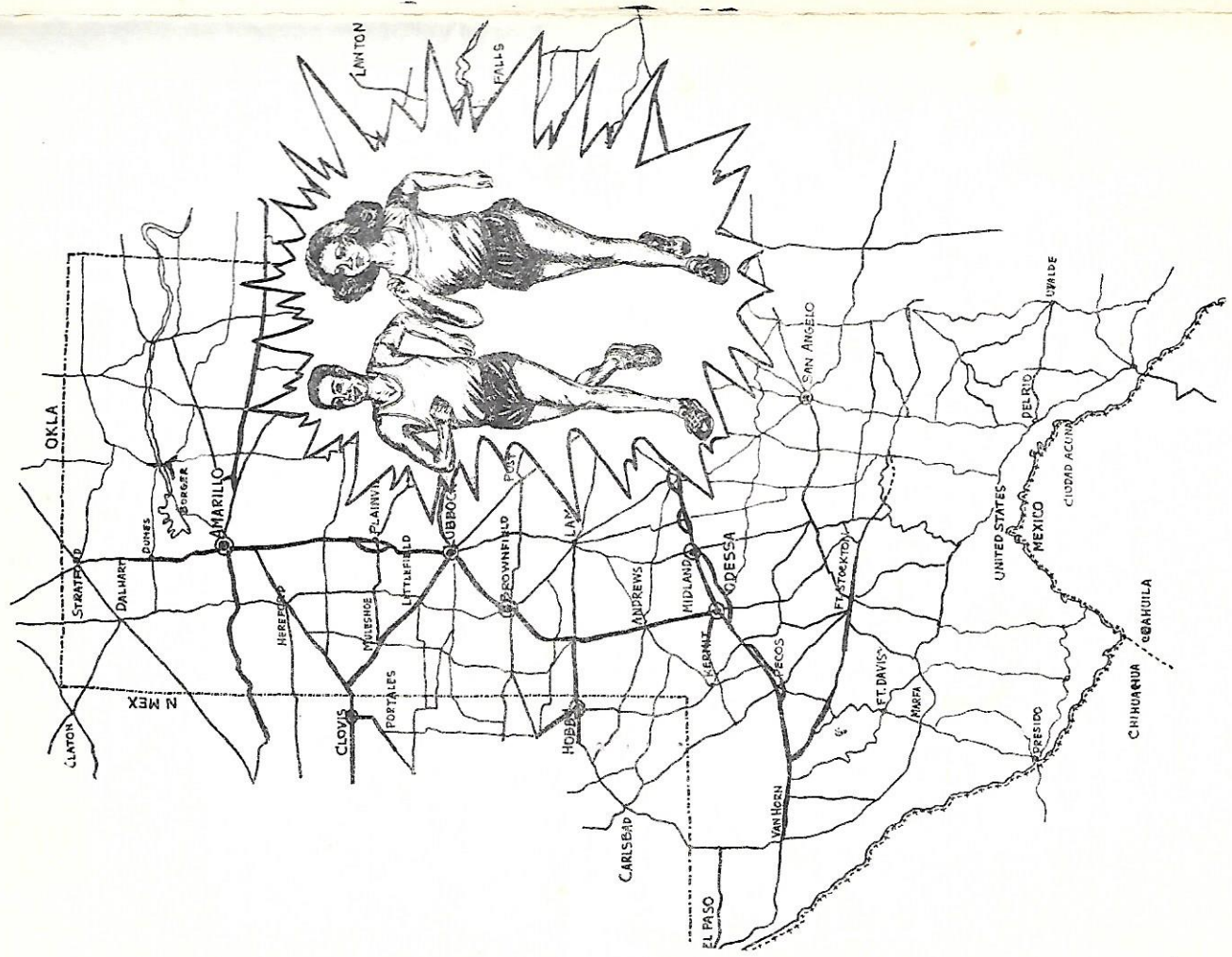

3 AND 6 MILE RACES

Floyd Gwin Park, Odessa, Texas

September 5, 1981

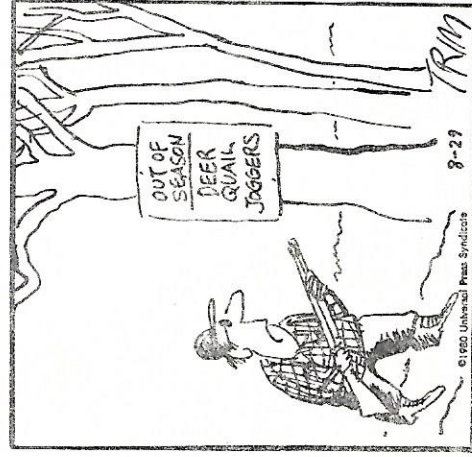
Seventy-nine runners toed the starting line on an ideal autumn morn to contest the annual tour of Floyd Gwin Park. While only two new standards were set, there were a number of noteworthy performances.

Leading the way to the finish line in the 3 miler was Cliff McCurdy (Lubbock) who ran a 15:03 to take the Open Division. Running second in 16:18 was Tino Arroyo (Odessa) who captured the High School Division. Bobby Cunningham (Abernathy) cruised the course in 16:37, captured the 40 and over Division, and smashed the long standing record of the late Jasper Peeples by more than a minute and a half. If ever there was a prompt recovery from hernia surgery, this has to be it. Fourth place was taken by Robert T.

(undecipherable signature) from Hobbs, N.M. whose 16:18 establishes a new mark in the 15 and under Division. Freddy Ortiz (Hobbs, N.M.) who followed close behind also broke the mark. NOTE: should any of our readers know the mystery runner from Hobbs, please provide the name so that we may acknowledge him. Also, in the future would all contestants letter their name on the entry forms -- not sign them in cursive. Among the other performances worth noting was that of George Jury (Lubbock) who ran a PR of 18:22. And, it was good to see Jack Petty (Ft. Stockton) again doing battle. He captured first place in the 30-39 Division, but was far off his record 15:12. That mark should stand for awhile, I'd imagine. Donna Repman (Midland) won the Girls (24 and Under) Division while Teri Valero (Midland) edged Linda Pollard (Odessa) in winning the Ladies (25 and Over) Division.

It was Hobbs, N.M. day in Odessa, Texas so far as the 6 mile race was concerned. Greg Meier edged Red Cloud by one second with a fine 30:21, and, four other "Hobbsons" followed close behind. Altogether, the New Mexicans captured the first six slots, and eight of the first ten places. Capturing seventh and winning the 30-39 Division in 36:19 was John Trompeter. Fellow Lubbockite Charles Davis finished ninth. Don Webb (Coahoma) won the 50 and Over Division while Francis Johns (Midland) was taking the 40-49 Division. It was particularly pleasant to see Gene Adams (Drownfield) donning the racing flats and competing again.

Sherill Easterling (Coahoma) captured the Ladies Division in 40:27. This is far off her excellent mark of 38:24 set just last year. She has sustained several injuries in the last six months, none nearly so painful as the recent death of her beloved husband. Sherill is an outstanding person and runner, and we can only marvel at her exemplary courage. Our sincere condolences, Sherill.

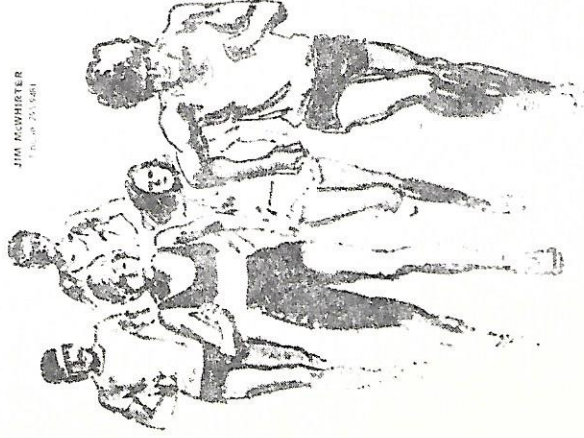
