Sixty three runners lined up to challenge the 5 mile course at Coleman Park in Brownfield on August 14th and were greeted by warm, humid weather with slight cooling from a south-westerly wind. Perhaps the most exciting duel took place between Cliff McCurdy, Gary Jenkins and Steve Stallings. With what must have been a tremendous kick, Cliff overcame a deficit of 20 to 30 yards in the last half mile of the race and moved from third place to finish first overall and win the Open Division in a time of 26:19.

Gary Jenkins (Lovington) was second overall in 26:26 and Steve Stallings (Stanton) captured the 30-39 Division and third place overall. Randall Marshall (Hobbs) took honors in the High School & Under group with a 29:45. Awe inspiring Donald Webb (Coahoma) covered the course in 31:18 to win the 50 & Over Division, and set a new course record by knocking 23 seconds off of the former mark set in 1980 by Don Sanderson. Sherill Easterling (Coahoma) won the Ladies Division with a 32:21 and also set a new course record by besting the old standard (which she set in 1979) by a whopping 1:40!! George Jury (Lubbock) cruised to a 40-49 Division win with a time of 32:29. George was beset with injury problems earlier this year and it's good to see him roaring back. Dedrick Pallanes (Hobbs) was tops in the 15 & Under Division, running the 5 miles in 35:29. Jeanette Reed (College Station) won the Girls (24 & Under) Division in 42:37.

On the improvement front, congratulations to Robby Timberlake (Leveland) for taking the coveted Handicap Trophy for August. Robby ran the course 1:23 faster than the time predicted for him. Also, take a look at the listing in this newsletter entitled Improvement 1982/1981, which shows the top ten most improved times for the August 5 Miler from 1981 to 1982. Some interesting stats!!

Last, but not least, thanks to Mickey McClure, Gene Adams and company for another fine race in Brownfield.

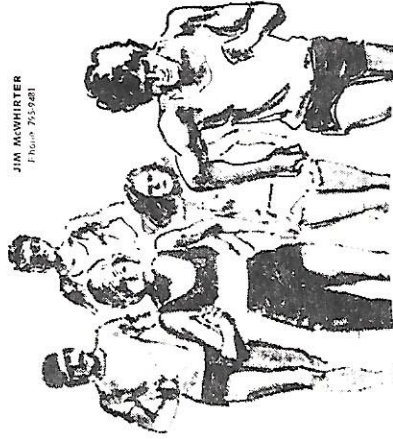

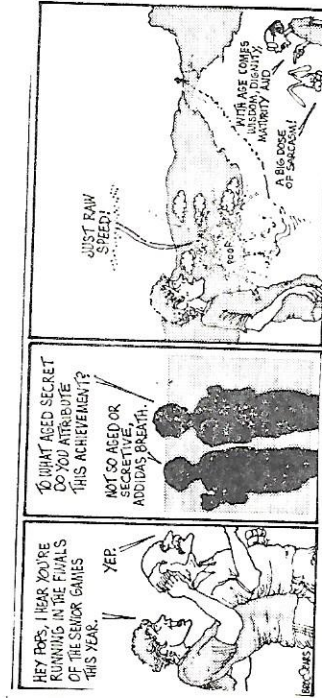
