

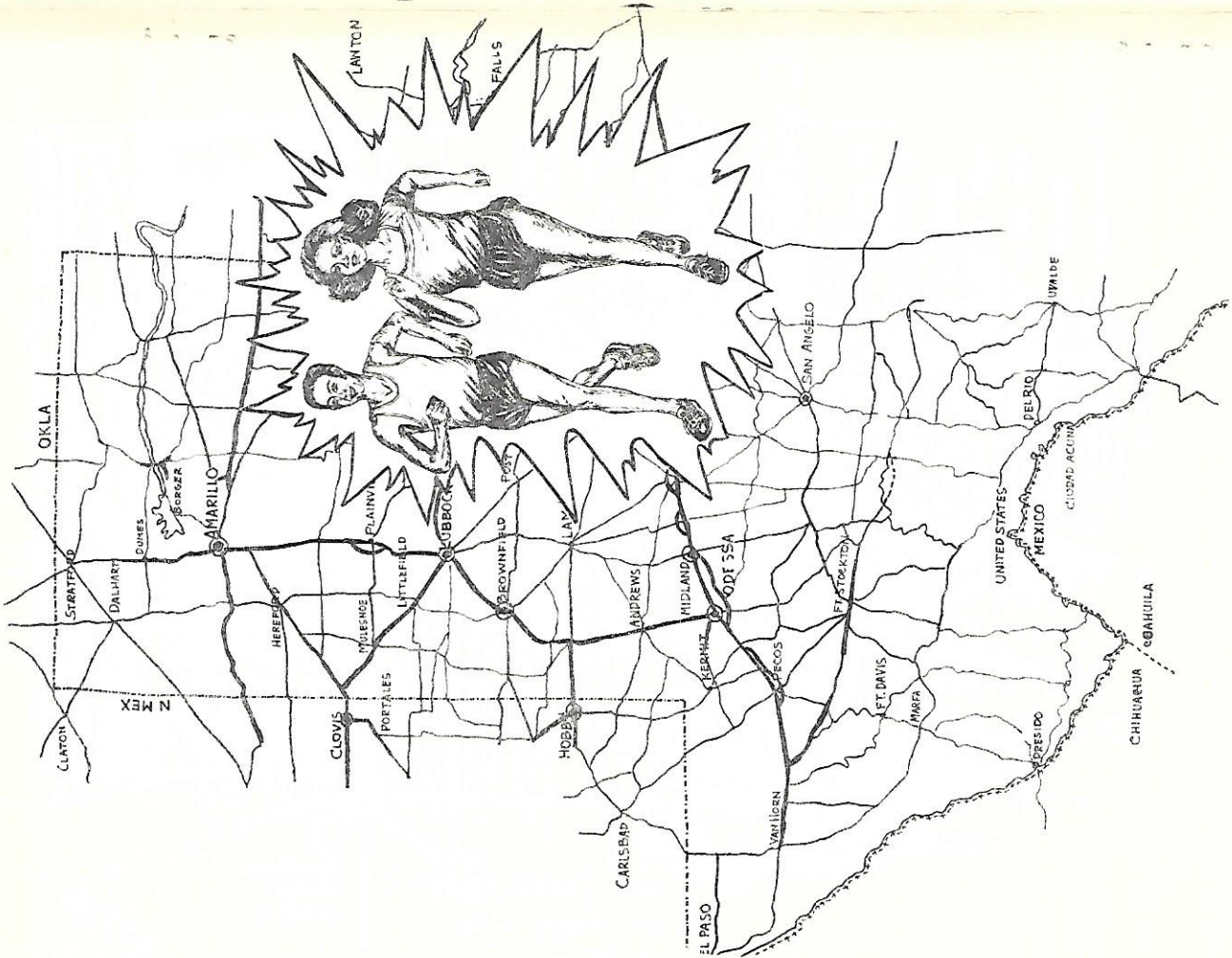

15th Annual 10, 3, and 1 Mile Races
Texas' Oldest Continuous Road Races
3 July 1982

A hot sunny noon greeted the one hundred twenty one triathletes who celebrated our nation's birthday by scavenging around Brownfield in the 14th running of the Wirecracker Road Races.

The overall winner in the children's 1-miler for the second year, in a row was the Canyon rocket J.J. Whitten with a tidy 5:50. Running second for the second year was eight year old Randall Leopard (Sweetwater) in a 6:06. Aki Davis (Slaton) took third overall in 6:18 as she edged Gary Whitten (Canyon) and Diana Guajardo (Levelland) in a close finish. Alexi Woodul (Lubbock) edged Holly Hodd (Union) to take the 10 and Under Girls' Division, while Ley Woodul won the 7 and Under Boy's Division.

Robert Schooler (Indian) in 14:53 edged Gary Jenkins (Levington) and Steve Stallings (Stanton) to win the 3-miler. Stallings captured the 30-39 category and his 15:02 knocked 16 seconds from the mark set just last year by John Behardski (Odessa). Running fourth was the Abernathy Flash Bobby Cummins, who evaporated Bob Dumar's 40-49 Division Standard with a scintillating 15:43. That's sixty one seconds faster than the old mark, folks!

The first high school finisher was Lubbock's Rodney Hendrix, who toured the course in 17:26. Fourteen year old Ruben Garbrano (Lawesa) ran a 17:43 to take the 15 and Under Division.

The Girl's 24 and Under Division was won in 19:17 by Veronica Cavazos (Lubbock), while Becky Wenden (Lubbock) won the Ladies 25 and Over Division in 23 minutes flat -- far off the record she set last year.

A number of club members have run the 3-miler in past years. A comparison of this year's results with past performances indicates Lloyd Escanilla (Cedar) knocked 32 seconds from last year's mark; Jerry Whitten (Canyon) improved by more than two minutes; and Cheri Livermore (Lubbock) set a course PR by more than three minutes. The author is too polite to mention those who have slowed down.

Quinn Smith (Levinston) led forty-six participants to the finish line in the 10-mile race with a 55:05. Lawesa's Carlos Ybarra in 56:53 and Houston's Henry Arellano in 57:32 captured second and third. Ron Shew (Lubbock), getting older, wiser, and better, took honors in the

30-39 Division with a 63:31. John Warner (Lubbock) edged Jay Sanchez (Amherst) to take the High School Division. In the 40-49 Division honors went to pended George Jury (Lubbock) in 69:21, and John Alexander (Carlsbad, Nv) won the 50 and Over Division. While not approaching her club record, injury-free Sherill Easterling (Coahoma) ran a commendable 68:17 to take top spot among the ladies.

Among the persons setting course PR's, perhaps the performance of James Livermore is most noteworthy. James first trod the ten-miler in 1979 when he ran an 86:20. He improved significantly each year and cruised the same roadway in 71:22 on this particular outing. Our Veep, Don Kephart (Lubbock), has knocked five minutes off his 1980 mark; Lyn Bowie (Lubbock) has pruned more than ten minutes, as has Kevin Taylor (Lubbock). George Jury (Lubbock) and Richard Kleinhans (Midland) have also shown marked improvement.

It needs to be stated. The 10-miler was hotly contested. It was evident from observing the finishers that the heat and humidity took its toll. The club members may wish to start the 15th Annual 10, 3, and 1-mile Races an hour earlier in order to avoid the heat of the day. If you have an opinion on the matter, please let the club officers know your feelings.

Street-joggers cited

HIGHLAND PARK (UPI) — The joggers running through the streets of this exclusive Dallas suburb will find it an expensive pastime if police catch up with them.

Highland Park authorities issued 13 tickets so far to joggers who run in the tree-lined streets rather than on the sidewalks in front of the high-priced homes. Violators risk \$15 fines.

The joggers are not pleased with this latest brand of law enforcement in a community where numerous arrests of people for being drunk-in-car spurred a lawsuit by those who claimed it was a way of harassing non-residents, especially minorities.

But Public Safety Commissioner Henry Gardner said Wednesday it's for the good of the runners.

"They're pretty upset about it," he said. "They don't even consider the fact that we're trying to save their life."

Gardner, who acts as police and fire chief, said authorities decided to issue the tickets after a female jogger was injured when she was hit by a car a month ago. The driver was intoxicated but officials believe the woman would not have been hit if she had been running on the sidewalk.

Gardner said joggers running in the streets also have caused accidents.

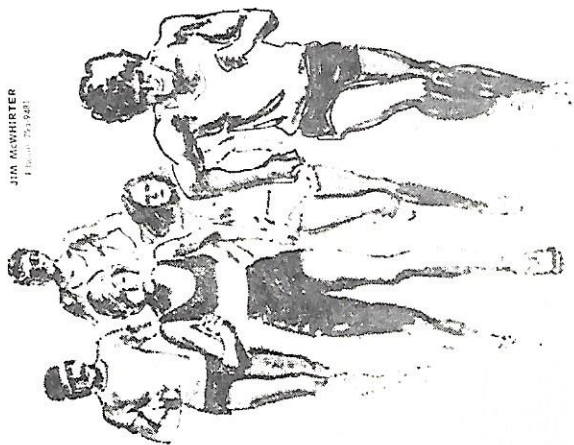
