3rd Annual Levelland Lope  
Levelland, Texas  
Saturday, June 5, 1982

One hundred sixty-eight assorted competitors attacked the three races that comprise Levelland's biggest annual running event, the Levelland Lope. With Bobby Birdsong and Frank Barker ably directing festivities, and generous sponsorship by Baggett Pharmacy, Neal Ellis Pharmacy and Gift Shop, and Levelland's Dairy Queens, festivities proceeded with nary a hitch. And for the very modest entry fee of \$2 or \$3, one hundred-twenty early registrants carted off a handsome new T-shirt, while sixty-three persons took home a trophy. The WRC may have low membership dues and be a non-profit organization, but a cheap operation it ain't!

Eleven year old Jason Moore (Lubbock) clocked a quick 6:00 in the 1-Mile Race for children to take top honors. Greg Malone (Dimmitt) edged Conrad Dennis (Lubbock) by 2 seconds to take second spot in 6:16. Staton's Ami Davis led the girl runners with a fine 6:32 as Liana Guajardo (Levelland) and Mary Whitten (Canyon) followed in 2nd and 3rd places. Noteworthy performances were also turned in by a pair of eight year olds. Brant Cline (Levelland) ran a 7:04 and Jimmy Whitten (Canyon) a 7:14.

Only one course record survived the day in the 5K race. Larry Chavez (Portales) led all runners in a sparkling 16:02 - breaking Buddy Hutto's old mark by 11 seconds. The old High School Division mark fell to sixteen year old John Warner (Staton) in 16:22. Bobby Cunningham (Abernathy) got in a little speed work as he turned in a 16:27 to wipe out the 40 and Over record. The 30-39 Division was captured by Garry Schovalisa (Amherst) in 17:24 in course record time as he edged Robert Guajardo (Levelland) - the previous record holder who set a PR. Staton's Paul Orr was two minutes ahead of the next 15 & Under contestant as he ran a 19:21 to eclipse the old mark by three minutes.

While not breaking Mindee Mayfield's Girls Record (24 & Under), Marie Marquez (Lovington, NM) turned in a creditable 21:53 to take top honors in that division. Becky Munden (Lubbock) won the Ladies Division in 23:47, knocking a full minute off her old mark. In all, seventy-nine persons completed the 5K race.

The 10K race was contested by sixty-seven runners. In this one, Bob Jackson (Amherst) edged Gary Jenkins (Lovington, NM) by one second to capture first place in 32:48. Quinn Smith (Lovington, NM) took third. Amarillo's Corky Fritch led the 30-39 Division runners with his 36:56 clocking while Royce Jones (Clovis, NM) was taking the 40-49 Division in 39:22. Jay Sanchez (Amherst) ran away and hid from the other High School 5 Under Division runners with his 37:17. His nearest competitor was more than 5 minutes behind!

While it is likely that most 10K runners were daunted by the brisk, humid headwind for miles two through four, Coahoma's Don Webb and Sherrill Easterling turned in record breaking performances anyway. Don, who is having an excellent season, broke Don Sanderson's mark with a 39:13. Sherrill, who has been on the mend, eclipsed her old standard by nearly three minutes with her 39:53 clocking.

Hats off to the Levelland Lope Race Committee and their aids for another first class series of races!

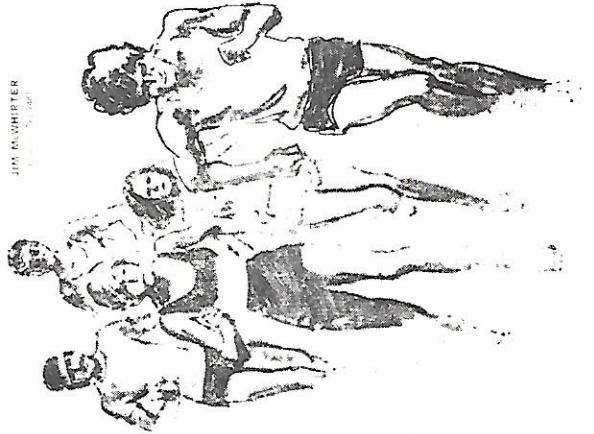
