

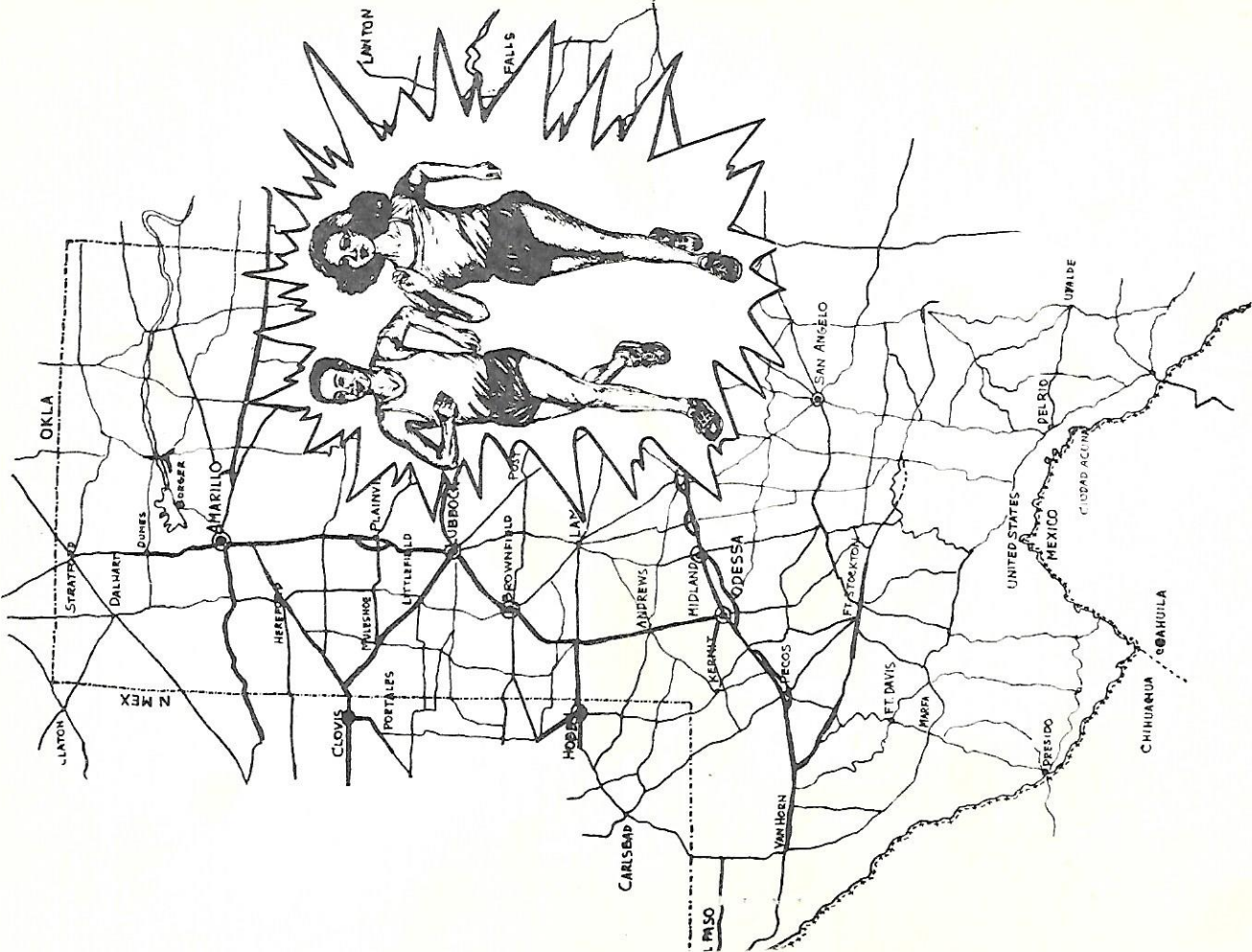

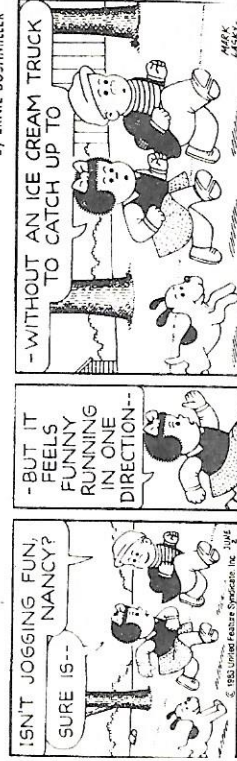

4th Annual "Levelland Lope"

The overcast skies and cooling breeze along with the participation of one hundred and thirty four runners made the "lope" a perfect ending to the West Texas Running Club's 1982-83 calendar of races. Special thanks to Frank Barker and of course the sponsors: Baggett Pharmacy, Neal Ellis Pharmacy and Gift Shop and the Levelland Dairy Queens.

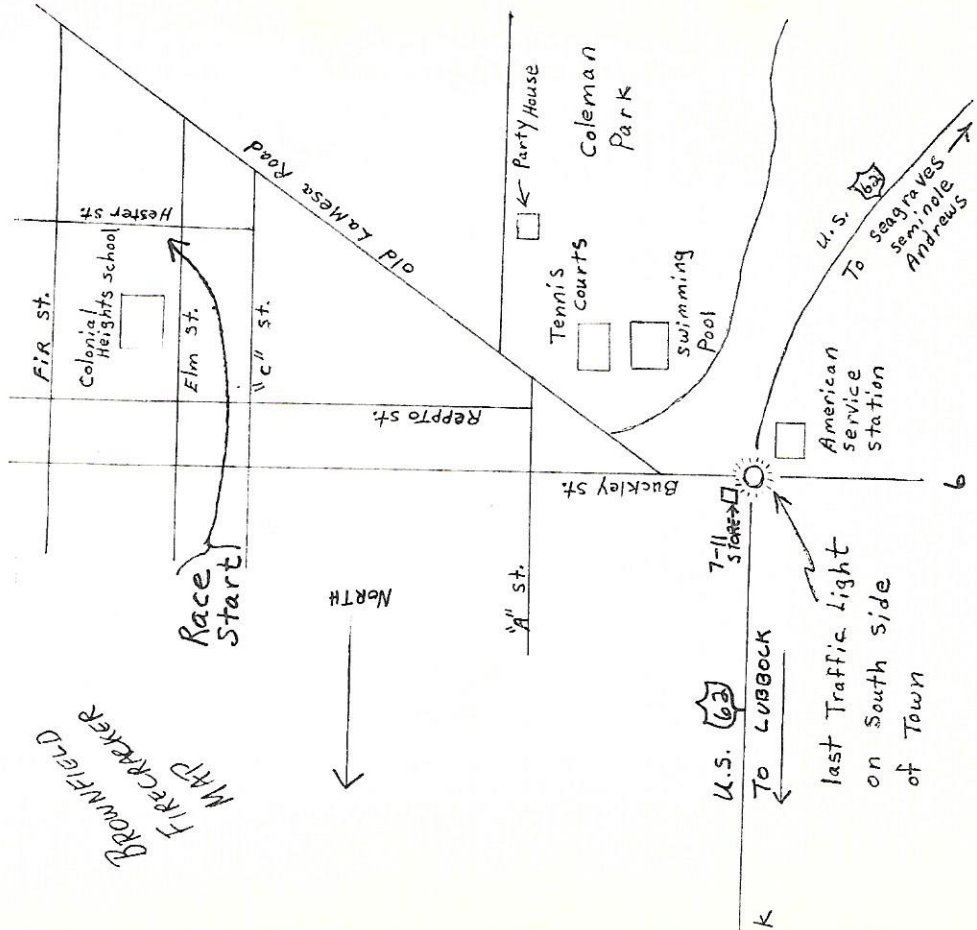
Although there was a distance problem in the One Mile Children's Race, all entrants gave a valiant effort with Anthony Morrison (Lubbock, 12) emerging as the victor over Albert Aguilar (Lamesa, 12) and Jason Shone (Lubbock, 12). Rosa Munez (Levelland, 12) led the girls followed by Anee Burks (Levelland, 10) and Jenny Smith (Lubbock, 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ ).

Several course records tumbled in the 5K Race, which saw Cliff McCurdy (Canadian) outleg Quinn Smith (Hobbs, NM) by one second for the overall victory. Cliff's time of 15:44 and Quinn's 15:45 effort both surpassed Larry Chavez's 1982 record of 16:02. Karl Wolfe (Big Spring) finished third overall and completed this group which captured the Open Division awards. Vince Mercado (Lubbock) blasted the 15 & Under Division by setting a new course record time of 18:01. He was followed by Artie Aguilar (Lamesa) and Charlie Douglas (Tatum, NM). Robert Tijerina (Hobbs, NM) led the High Schoolers and finished fourth overall in 16:48. A strong Bobby Cunningham (Abernathy) continued his winning ways as his 16:50 effort led him to the 40 & Over title while finishing 5th overall. Gary Schovajsa (Sundown) won the 30-39 group in 17:40. And while Ann Gordhamer (Lubbock) was setting a new Ladies record in 22:54, Jackie Davis (Slaton) and Josie Aleman (Lubbock) continued their ongoing battle to the finish line! This time, Jackie earned a hard fought three second victory over her friendly rival. In all, sixty seven persons competed and finished the 5K Race.

While there were no new records set in the 10K Race, Gary Jenkins (Lovington, NM) came close as he cruised the out and back in a fine 32:33. Two minutes and ten seconds later saw Dennis Grunstad (Lubbock) finish second overall while Lolo Mercado (Ibk) closed out the Open Division. Brownfield's Dan Fonseca prevailed in the 30-39 Division with a fine 37:07 effort, while Bennie Pickrell (Littlefield) led the 40-49'ers in 38:47. Lyn Bowie (Lubbock) continues to improve as she led the Ladies Division in 50:38. The Lope turned in a family affair for several local runners. Johnny Mercado (Lubbock) joined brothers Vince and Lolo in the winners circle by taking the High School & Under title, while the Sifuentes (Welch) group of Rosie, Janie and Tammy made a clean sweep of the Girls Division.

Special note should be made of one member of the WTRC. Jim Wilhelm (Lubbock), despite being troubled by a nagging knee injury for the latter part of the racing year, gritted his teeth, swallowed several aspirins and held together to win this year's Mileage Award. Congratulations, Jim!!! You can ride that "Chrome Three Wheeler" the rest of the way!

Every finisher has a success story of its own. We hope you had lots of finishes and a bunch of good stories from this past racing year. Come to Brownfield July 4th for "Firecracker Run XV". Good Running!!!
