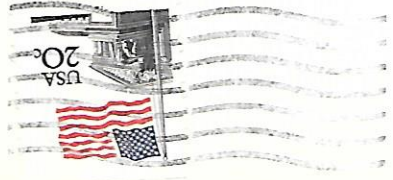

Stroh's Run For Liberty

Over 400 runners registered for the Stroh's Run for Liberty I held near Lubbock at Reese Air Force Base on October 13, 1984. Lubbock was one of 123 cities in the U.S. selected to host the Run for Liberty which was the largest single day running event in history. Proceeds from the race were earmarked for the Statue of Liberty Restoration Fund. Restoration is scheduled to be completed in 1986 at a cost of \$230,000,000. The race was directed by Don Kephart, Jim Wilhelm, James Livermore and Mike Kelley.

Runners were greeted with beautiful weather (temperatures in the mid 50's and winds light and variable) as they attacked the 8,000 meter out and back course (cert. pend.) which started and finished at the Reese Picnic Area.
