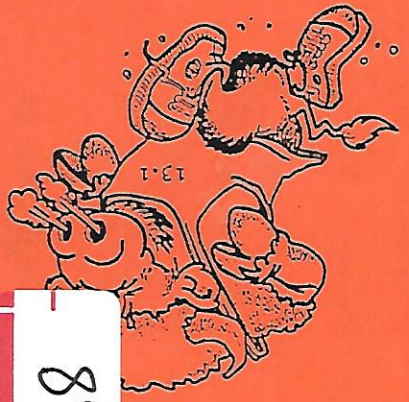

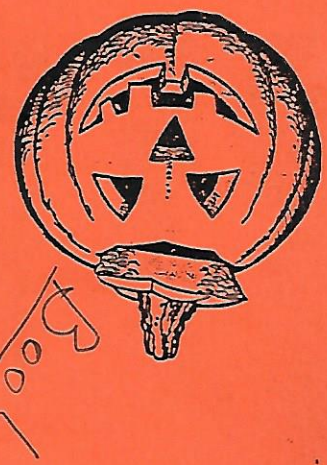

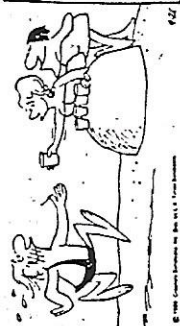

# Happiness

From: The Complete Runner's Day-by-Day Log & Calendar 1988 by: John Jerome

After all these years, and all these millions of runners, the nonrunning press still shows occasional hostility toward the sport. No part of the press does so more consistently than sportswriters. And nothing that uncomprehending sportswriters can find to say is any sappier than the complaint that runners look unhappy when they run.

This noncomprehension is surely willful. It's a defense against complexity. Sportswriters (to my occasional regret, I'm one of them) seek simplicity, explanations, unquestioned outcomes. A hanging curve that gets knocked over the fence, the long bomb over the safety's head, are powerful explanations of why one team and not the other won the contest. Even who crosses the finish line first—never mind why—is acceptably unambiguous, although track sports, eschewing violence along with sticks and balls, are perilously close to a nonsport in most writers' eyes.

Track and field events have outcomes. Road-racing events have outcomes, and are therefore finally getting some attention from the nonspecialist press. (Cash prizes in road-running events have begun to generate more press coverage than all the 20,000-runner fields of the previous three decades combined. Editors understand dollar amounts a lot better than they understand running.) Running itself—for recreation, for pleasure, never mind about health or even athletic training—is incomprehensible to the sportswriting mind. If nobody wins, how do you tell when you're done?

You can't really blame the writers for focusing on results: they have to have something to print. You also can't blame the athletes, in any sport, for their natural distrust of the press. Athletes know that sports start with play, with process; writers for some reason have trouble comprehending that. Athletes know that it's the doing, not the winning, that keeps you coming back. This has even been institutionalized, in the old cliché about it mattering not whether you win or lose but how you play the game. Unfortunately it was a writer, not an athlete, who did the institutionalizing, and he missed the point. How you play the game implies a Victorian moralism; the athlete knows it's just the doing that really counts. It's *that* you play the game; getting out and experiencing it. Character, like winning, is a side issue; the pleasure of the effort is what keeps sports alive.

Another cliché says that most writers don't want to write, they want to have written: the doing is too painful. Maybe that's why they misunderstand running. Stuck for another column, they growl about the pained expressions they see on the faces of the runners (as they drive to work). It's sportswriting's version of "if you're so smart, why aren't you rich?" If running is so much fun, then why are runners always grimacing so? How can it make you happy when I can tell just by looking that it hurts?

Someone ought to point out to these astute observers that violinists also usually look unhappy, at the very moments when they are re-creating the most soaring triumphs of man's creativity. Winning quarterbacks look unhappy, for crissakes, right up to the final gun. A happy smile is a *result*, like a final score. We smile in the shower; while we're running, we're too busy having fun. Too busy being happy to smile about it.
