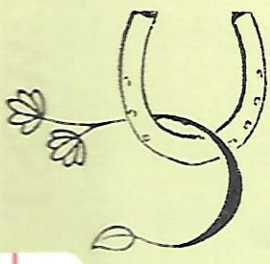

FLIGHT LINE 1/2 Marathon, 10K & 2 mi. Runs

Reese Air Force Base April 8, 1989

Designated Event No. 4 of W.T.R.C. Challenge Series

It's a rule.

The wind has to be blowing at more than a 30+ MPH clip in order for there to be an official W.T.R.C. event at Reese Air Force Base. (Remember last year's Flight Line & this year's M.L.K. Memorial? Nevertheless, the gusting gales did not deter 77 rugged runners from tackling the 3rd Annual Flight Line Runs which saw three new course records established.

Scott Brickerd paid little heed to the north easterly winds and cruised to a new half marathon overall course record of 1:16:24, besting Lolo Mercado's 1987 effort of 1:18:17 and Lou Kohagen's 30-39 Age Division record of 1:18:49 also set in '87. Joe Post's 1:31:53 topped Larry Byrd's 1987 mark of 1:41:40.4 in the 40-49 Age Division. Brian Brashears sped to an 11:02.8 in the Two Mile, breaking Chris Engebretson's 19 & Under record of 11:08 set in 1988. No 10K records were broken.

Thanks are extended to Race Director Ronnie Nugent and his able crew of designated volunteers Tony Aleman, Ann Davis and Mark Manley. We also appreciate the help provided by runners Joe Gomez, Jimmy Samarron and Jim Wilhelm who all lent helping hands after their runs. Thanks also to Teresa Manley & Sally Post for their valuable assistance.

Special appreciation is also noted for Randy Pratt, Jake Trevino and all the folks from the Reese Physical Fitness Center without whose cooperation and work the W.T.R.C. would not be able to offer a long distance, three event run.

Flight Line Facts: Half marathoners bettering their 1987 times were Joe Post with a 2:34 improvement and Al Grotz :32 better than last year. 2 Milers improving '87 performances were Josie Aleman by :45 and Jimmy Samarron by :11. Bill Roerer was the only 10Ker to improve over last year, but he did so by a whopping 5:49.

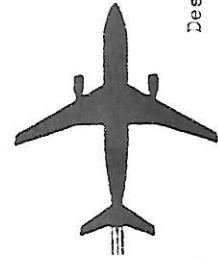
Fast Fliers: Given the wind factor, overall times would seem to be darn respectable. Half of the 2 Mile field were under 15:00 (7:30 pace), half of the 10K field were at 47:30 or better (7:39 pace); half of the half marathon field turned in times of 1:41:30 or under (7:45 pace). Congratulations are due to all competitors for having won personal victories over the very difficult conditions at the 1989 Flight Line.

Flight Line Figures: The 59 W.T.R.C. entrants (18 more military entrants also competed) brings the attendance at the first four W.T.R.C. events for '89 to 208 as compared to 198 for the same period last year. Hope everybody will try and be out for the 17th Annual Horseshoe Bend Canyon Spring Frolic on May 13 (more info. listed in this issue).
