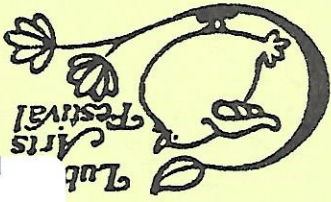


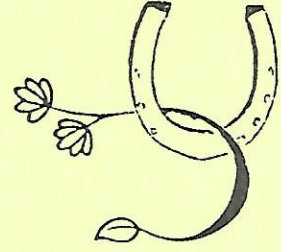

TRIATHLETE NEWS

WHY MEN SHAVE THEIR LEGS: Some 5 years ago when I started doing the triathlon scene, I noticed that there were some strange rituals that the triathlete went through. 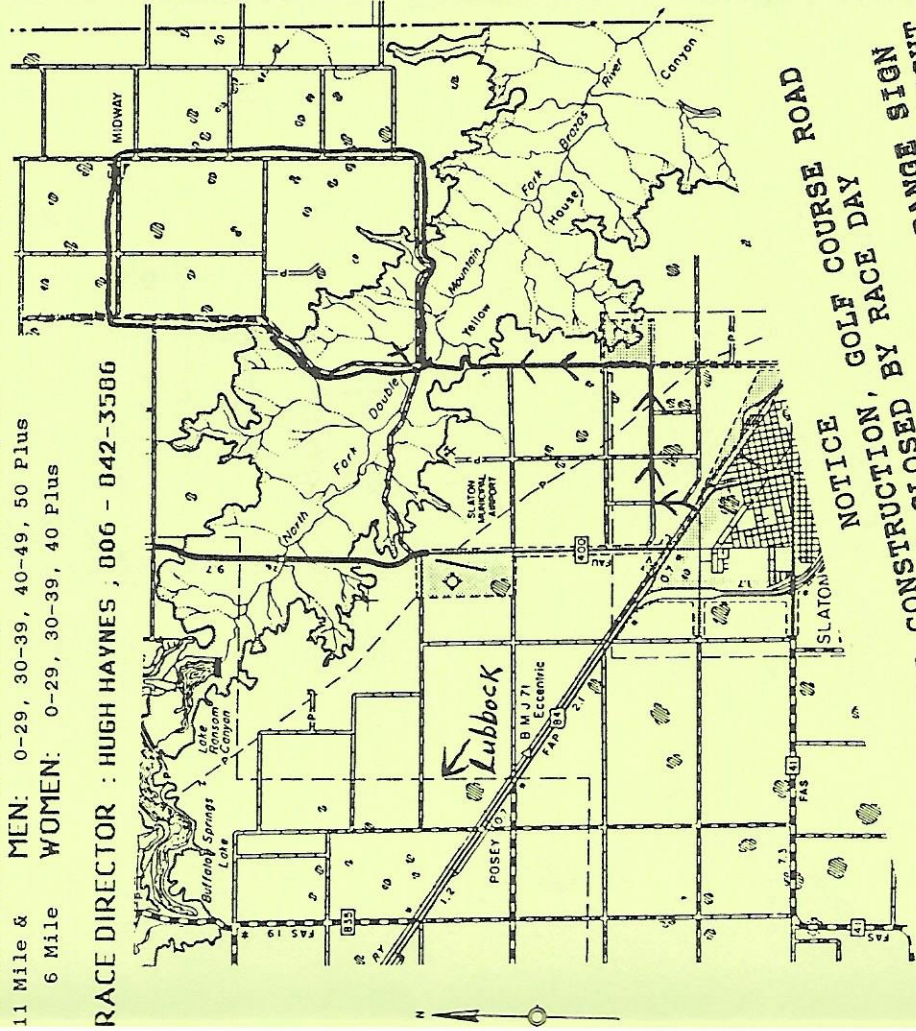
