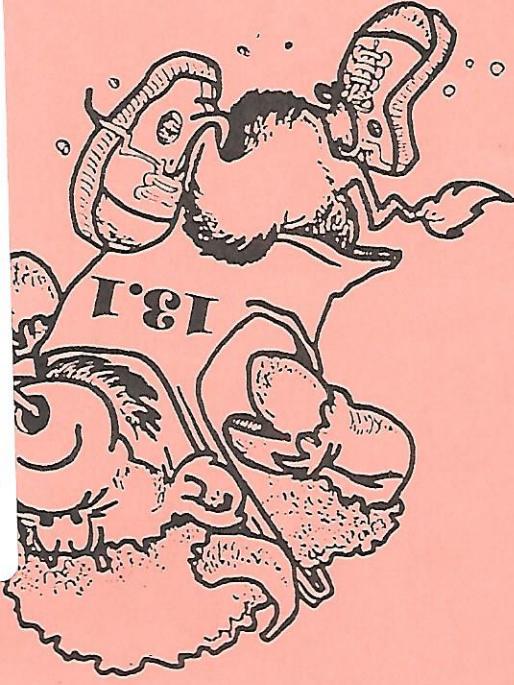

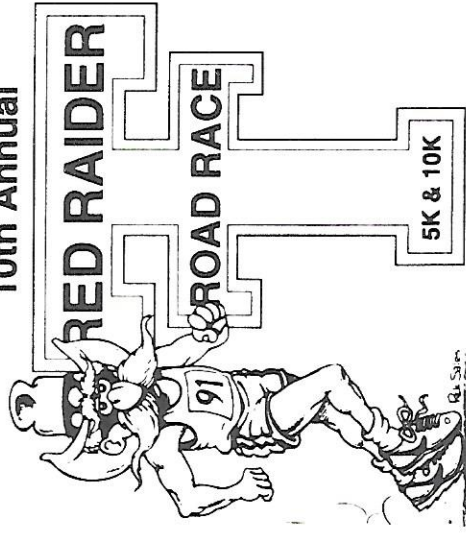

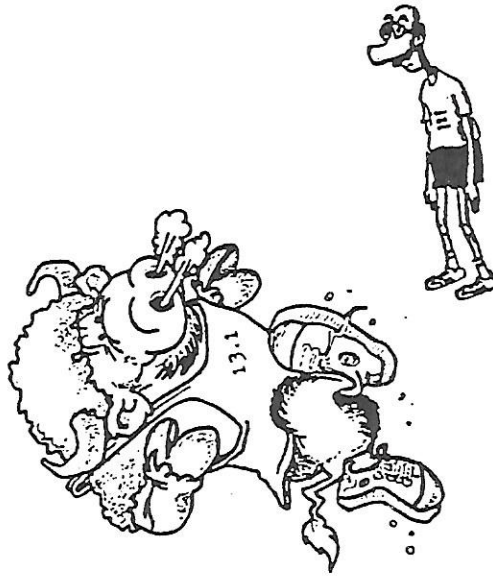

EDITORIAL

As I mentioned the helpers I had for the RED RAIDER ROAD RACE. I thought to myself, as much fun as we all have participating in such an event, why we don't have more people willing to volunteer, especially when they are hurt and can't run themselves. Another thought that came to mind also, was the fact that we have a lot of people who are members that used to run in our races but no longer do. I realize that as we age and suffer injuries that slow us down we might have the tendency to shy away from competition, but we shouldn't feel bad if we "Give it all we've Got" on any particular day. As one who has run pretty extensively since 1979, logging around 25,000 miles, there have been times when I've felt like giving it up as I am sure many of you have too. Up until 1978 I had jogged to try to improve my cardiovascular fitness and control my girth but only got around 450 miles per year in. It was the encouragement of W.T.R.C. members and the forum the club races provided that has kept me motivated. After running seriously for 8 years I was able to set all my PR's, but since 2 years ago one trouble followed another so that now I hope that I am on the comeback trail even though a hard or long run (10 miles is my maximum now) still causes twinges of pain in the old sciatic. As I have carefully observed, I notice a lot of runners build up their mileage and complete marathons, then begin to "burn out". The one thing that enabled me to accomplish my PR's at a pretty late age was the practice of running no more than 5 days a week and only doing a long run every other week. I suspect that I will never be able to do another marathon but I revel in the ability of others to do so. What I am really trying to say is that we should use the races as a measurement for ourselves and not how we stack up against others. With that in mind I would encourage everyone to keep on participating in the club events if only to encourage those who are struggling with motivation.

Do more than belong, participate.

Do more than care, help.

Do more than believe, practice.

Do more than be fair, be kind.

Do more than forgive, forget.

Do more than dream, work.
