Location: Horseshoe Bend Canyon, Slaton, Texas. Take U.S. 84 to Slaton (approximately 16 miles from Lubbock) and turn left between Salton Gas & Equipment and Montgomery & Schell Co. Follow this road to the second right turn and turn there onto a paved road. Stay on the paved road past the golf course for approximately 2-3 miles to the starting line at the bottom of the canyon.

Course: 11-mile - looped course. One steep hill at one mile mark. Rest flat or downhill. Asphalt. Old course, new distance, no turn-around in last mile. 2-mile - out and back. Flat asphalt.
