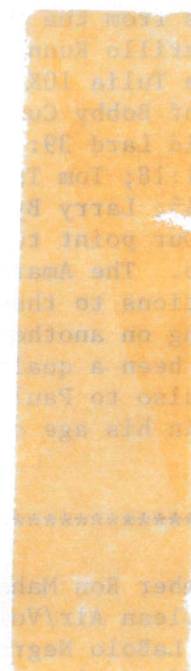

Club Members James Livermore and Jim Wilhelm also ran the ½ marathon, but times were unavailable. Congratulations to all who participated.

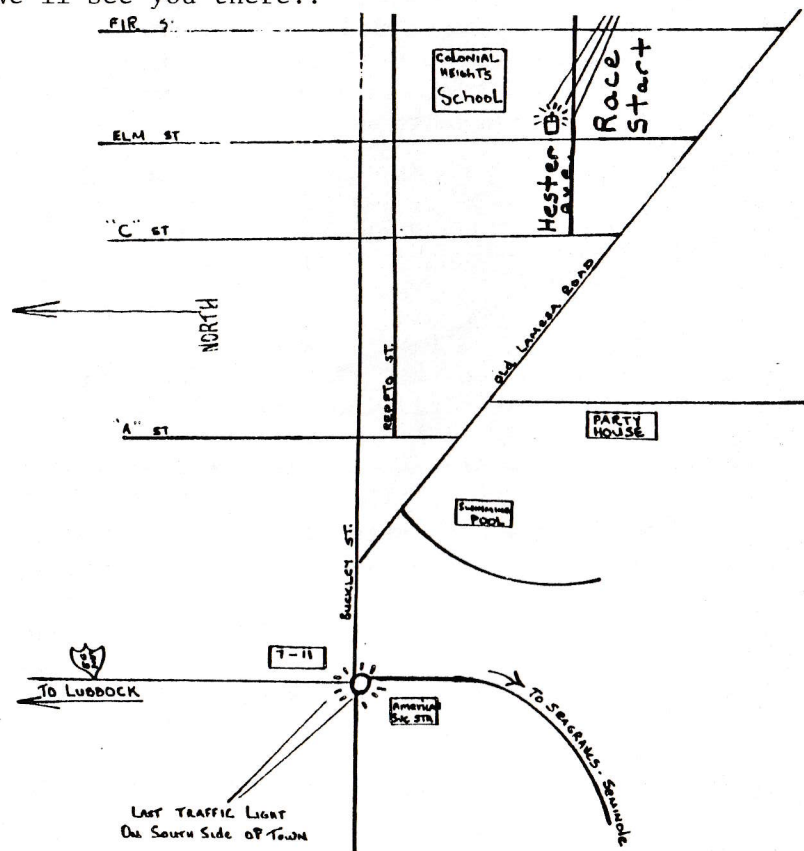
