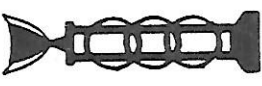

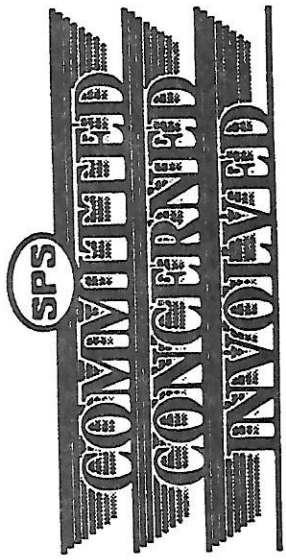

1994 CHALLENGE SERIES RULES

*** The West Texas Running Club's 1994 Challenge Series ***

The WTRC CHALLENGE SERIES continues for 1994, as a 12 month series of races culminating in year-end awards for performance, endurance and participation by club members in our monthly club races. The tentative Schedule of Events is listed in the calendar of each newsletter, and each month's designated race will be detailed in the W.T.R.C. Newsletter prior to that race. Additional categories this year will recognize non running volunteers and provide awards for the most improved runners over the 12 month period. All members desiring to participate in the 1994 Challenge Series must volunteer to serve as a non-running worker at one Challenge Series event as an entry requirement.

The 1994 Challenge Series features these categories:

1. 66 Mile Club ** All members completing 66 miles in qualifying events will receive an award denoting that achievement. There will be a total of approximately 90 qualifying miles available. Any member serving as RACE DIRECTOR will be credited with double mileage for the most miles in that event. Any member who serves as a volunteer will be credited for the most miles at those races.
2. MILEAGE AWARD *** An award will be presented to the male and female members who accumulate the most miles for the year in qualifying events. All provisions for Race Directors and volunteers listed above apply to this category.
3. PARTICIPATION AWARD *** An award will be presented to the male and female members who participate in the greatest number of qualifying events. All provisions for Race Directors and volunteers apply to this category.
4. VOLUNTEER OF THE YEAR ** Three awards will be given to those non runners who help the most at club sanctioned events. These selections will be made by the Race Directors.
5. MOST IMPROVED RUNNER AWARD ** A point score for each club member will be kept and averaged after each race on the runners race time as compared to the world's best for the particular distance. Club member's starting point will be calculated from the 1993 race results and will require a minimum of 3 races to enter and one must participate in 8 of the 12 events in the current year to be eligible for awards. The names of the top 10 will be published each quarter in the newsletter.
6. VICTOR'S RANKINGS *** Points will be earned at each qualifying event in the following Age and Sex groupings:
 - A. Divisions will include: MALE AGE GROUPS; 0-19, 20-29, 30-34, 35-39, 40-44, 45-49, 50-54, 55-59 and 60 Plus
FEMALE AGE GROUPS; 0-19, 20-29, 30-34, 35-39, 40-44, and 45 Plus
 - B. The 1st place finisher in each division at each distance at each qualifying event will earn 10 points, the 2nd place finisher 9 points, 3rd place finisher 8 points, and so on down to 1 point for 10th place finisher. This rewards both performance and participation, i.e., if a runner finishes last in their division, but only 3 other runners in that division attend that race, the last place finisher would still earn 7 points for a 4th place finish. This allows slower runners who attend more races to accumulate additional points over their faster competitors who do not participate as often. For example, a runner who attends 10 events and earns 6 points at each would have more points than a competitor who won each of 5 events he entered, thus rewarding participation and performance. Also, runners may enter any distance available at a qualifying event and still earn points.
 - C. Awards will be presented to the first 3 and to at least 50% of the number of the top point scorers in each division. The number of awards to be given in each division will be determined at a future date after consideration of the number of Challenge Series participants. Awards will be presented at a year end membership meeting.
 - D. Monthly Challenge Series Statistical Updates will appear in the Newsletter.

NEWS

THE SUPREME MASTER'S RUNNER

The March/April issue of "ON THE ROADS" the periodical of USAT&F featured biographies of Rae Baymiller and Doug Kurtis. Baymiller just recently started running and at 49 ran her first marathon in 3:18:11 on an average of 40 miles per week. During 1993 she upped her mileage to 50 and at age 50 set a US masters' half-marathon record of 1:19:40, September 19th, and later at New York, she ran a 2:53:53, 3rd master, 4th American and 23rd overall, got the course age group record and the 4th all time performance in the 50-54 age division.

In contrast, Doug Kurtis has been running a long time and since the portion of the article reprinted below, has finished 3rd at the Las Vegas Marathon in 2:19:26, won the Austin Marathon in 2:12:35 and at Boston ran his 75th sub 2:20, finishing 29th overall and setting a new USA masters' record of 2:15:48. He has won 37 of his 153 marathons and has never had a serious injury or had surgery. He also holds down a full time job and is the father of two boys. He averages close to 100 miles per week!

begging seventy-three (73) of them since 1980, a record. Last May at Revco-Cleveland (2:19:21), Doug passed Sweden's Kjell-Erik Stahl's old mark (69).

More Than a Marathon Man

If Baymiller is "the new kid on the block", Doug Kurtis, 41, is the seasoned veteran. A five-time Olympic Trials marathon qualifier ('80-'96), Kurtis has been a competitive national/world class road runner for fifteen straight years, a consistency perhaps only Bill Rodgers can match.

For the second consecutive year, Kurtis, from Northville, Michigan, is the top ranked American master runner in the USA Tri Masters Road Rankings (see pages one, four and ten) as well as #2 male master overall for the year and #6 in '92.

1993 has been his "most memorable year" not only performance-wise, but also monetarily.

Best known for his string of sub-2:20 marathons, to-date, he has run a mind-

THE FOUR MINUTE MILE

May 6, 1954, Roger Bannister broke the four minute barrier and on February 20, 1994, nearly 40 years later, Eamonn Coghlan at age 41, became the first master to break that barrier with a 3:58.15 on the indoor track at Harvard. Coghlan still holds the world indoor mile record of 3:49.78 which he set back in 1983. Many of the indoor tracks back east are banked wood construction, so Coghlan has been dubbed Chairman of the Boards. He came tantalizingly close last year with a then masters record 4:01.39. Mile greats, John Walker and Rod Dixon have tried but failed to reach the magic mark and now both are retired due to nagging injuries.

I believe that American, Steve Scott, is getting up in his 30's so maybe he'll be the next master to set the record.

JEREMY STALLINGS

I had not heard anything about Jeremy Stallings' performances in his first year at Florida, so when I wrote to his dad, Steve, at Stanton to invite him to the 25th FIRECRACKER RUN, I asked him to update me on Jeremy. It seems that Jeremy finished 4th in the SEC meet at Arkansas with a 1:49.11 in the 800M, and has a season best time of 1:48.27, placing him 13th in the NCAA and the top 18 times qualify for the NCAA meet June 1-4, in Boise, Idaho. Not bad for a freshman! He also has run some 47 second legs on the team's 1600M relay this season. The NCAA meet will probably be on some cable network, so be on the lookout for Jeremy Stallings!
