

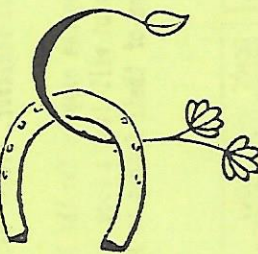

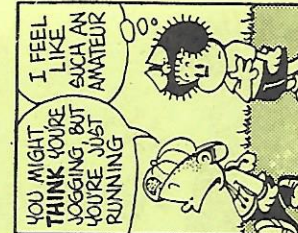
W.T.R.C. RACES ARE USUALLY HELD THE SECOND SATURDAY OF EACH MONTH

Joe also still owns the 40 to 44 Half Marathon record. It is a known fact that the wind will hamper the runners of this race to some degree. The only question is "How Much"!

The wind for the 8th running of the FLIGHT LINE RACES was considerably less than usual and the dirt didn't get up until the last runner had finished. Seventy eight finished this year's event, and 17 club members as well as Ida Sumpter and some of the RAFB people served as volunteers.

AT THE RACES

Shirley Wigley was in Austin March 20th, entered the FLAMINGO 5K along with 1,200 others, and won her age group with a fine 24:11.

Richard Fischenich has recovered from his knee surgery and posted a PR 3:24:38 at the MARATHON OF THE GREAT SOUTHWEST in Abilene, April 16th. New club member Chris Strathman, ran her first marathon in six years there, and posted a fine 3:30:31.

"Marathon man" Richard Bray ran the LAKE POWELL MARATHON at Page, AZ, in 4:11. He remarked that it was one mountain after another!

Marjory Stewart ran the 98th BOSTON MARATHON in 2:58:14. I got to watch most of it on TV and was thrilled with the real close finish and course record times. American Bob Kempainen finished 7th with an American record 2:08:47, previously set by Alberto Salazar in 1982.

Jim and Jeanie Leser happened to be in England for a vacation, so Jim had entered the LONDON MARATHON and ran 3:24.

Club members running the 2 Mile at the SPRING FEVER RUN listed by order of overall finish and times were: (1) Frank Sumpter, Sr., 11:35, (3) P. J. Mitchell, 15:35, (4) Brenda Campbell, 16:25, (6) Maria Jeffery, 18:26, (7) Casey Sumpter, 20:11, (8) Johnny Martinez, 20:54, and Bernice Nelson paced little brother, Charlie to a 22:28. Bernice had placed 5th at the district meet the day before in both the 1600 and 3200, with times of 7:13 and 15:39.

Other HS runners listed in district results were; Trey Jennigan, Sundown, 1st in the 1600 and 3200 in 5:02 and 10:39. Karen Bonner, 3rd in the 3200 in 12:35. John Rodriguez 2nd in the 1600 in 4:41. Over in Ruidoso, New Mexico, Jay Truitt ran 800M in 2:04 and 1600M in 4:42.

MOST IMPROVED RUNNER STANDINGS

The base for each club member has been established from the "Performance Factor" figured on at least 3 races competed in last year, or a total of 3 races last year and this year. After this base is set the average of at least 3 of the first 4 races run is compared against the base and the difference is expressed as plus or minus. Naturally, the most improved runners will have a higher performance factor average than their base qualifying figure. We plan on reporting these standings each quarter, so the next listing will be in the July newsletter and will require participation in four of the first six races. The current "Top 10" are:

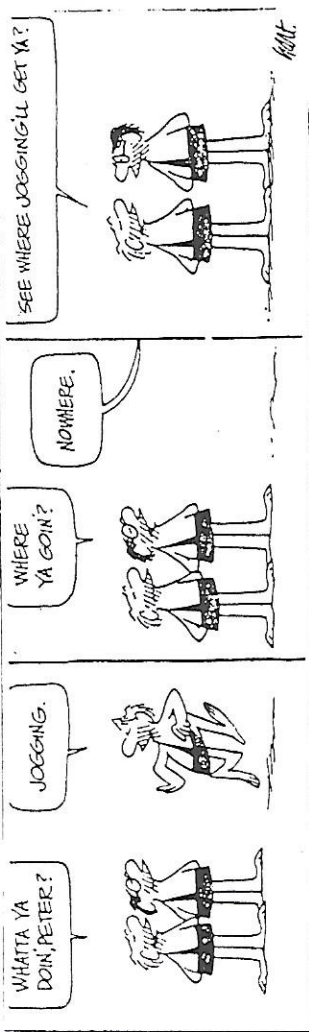

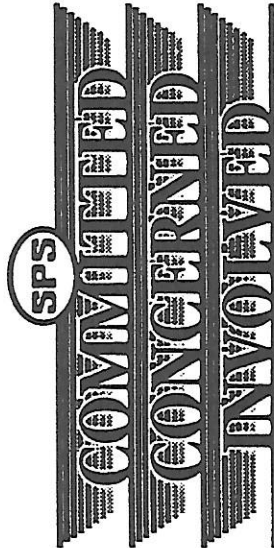

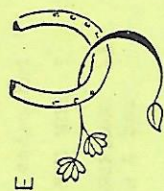
