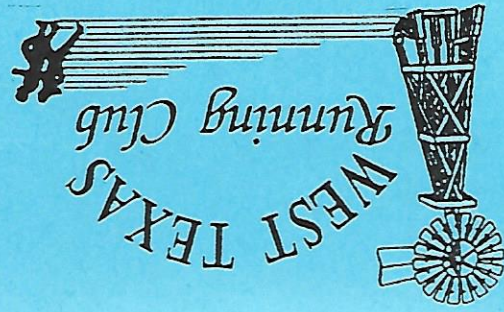

## RACE DIRECTOR'S REPORT

A clear dry morning greeted 36 runners for the 10th Annual "REDLINE" with a reported low temperature of 12 and a wind chill of +2 (that's 1 warmer than the wind chill last year!) Participants from as far away as Hobbs NM, Lamesa, and Earth attacked the tough hills of Mae Simmons Park while trying to keep warm after a cold front brought the worst chill this fall. Jackson Makene of SPC led the field in 21:57, the second fastest time ever posted in this race. (Record by Rodney Hendrix, 21:19 in 1987) Two of our New Mexico members followed close behind, with last year's winner, Bob Jackson, 2nd in 22:50 and Jay Truitt taking 3rd in 23:02. First place female, Hope Jimenez led the women for the second year in a row, with her sister, Mary Lou, next overall. Brother J.R. and little sister Margarita completed the Lamesa team. Three of the original 1986 Redliners returned again: Luis Cardenas, James Livermore and John Stalcup. Thanks to volunteers Molly Santese, Tony Aleman, James Bone, Etta Mayer, Marsha Bennett, George Jury and David Skelton who helped keep runners on course. 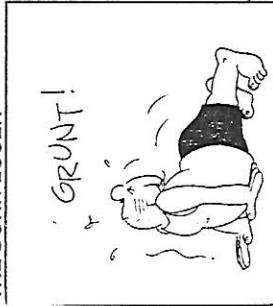
