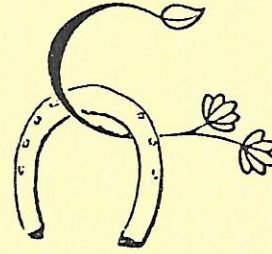


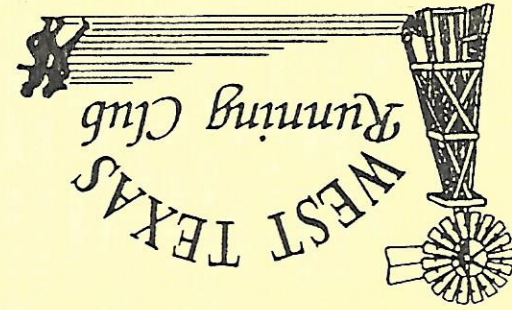

AT THE RACES

Twice before, I had signed up to run the CAPITOL 10,000 in Austin, but had to cancel at the last minute. This time the March 24th date coincided with our son Brad's time off for spring break and I was actually able to enter. I was fearful of jockeying for a starting position with 17,000 other runners, but was privileged to be among the "seeded" group in the "competitors" race which started 15 minutes before the masses. I was able to work my way from the back up to my "C" group area and found I had plenty of room and could see the front row, only 10 or so rows ahead. After a quick start I soon found out that the street was a wide Blvd. of 6 or 8 lanes and within 20 seconds there were hundreds of runners ahead of me, one of which I recognized as Mike Flores, and I lost sight of him pretty soon. This is not a PR course as there are two really long hills and other lesser ones. On this date the temperature was in the mid 70's and the humidity 99 percent. It did start to drizzle at about 45 minutes into the race. The only results published were for the competitors' race of which there were 386 listed. This was my first race because of injuries in 8 months and I just wanted to see how far I had to go in my recovery after building back up to 24-26 miles a week and never wearing a watch. I did accidentally see Carlos Vigil after I finished and was waiting on my son-in-law. I later learned he had run the "citizens" race (along with George Bush) and that he had run a 41:17 which would have given him 8th in his age group. Others that I know of who ran with the masses were Gail Blackmon and Bill Hopkins, Jim Harris and Mark Veteto. Other club members found in the results were: Hawk Harris, 37:44, 9th AG, Bob Jackson, 35:20, 4th AG, Mike Flores, 39:01, 13th AG, and a new member, Christi Lammers, 39, of Midland who was 2nd AG with a 40:17. They gave Age Group awards 10 deep this year and they are large, heavy medallions.

At the PECOS STAMPEDE in Roswell March 16th, Hawk Harris was 2nd overall in the 10K and 1st AG. Jim and Mary Harris also participated and John & Doris Stalcup race walked the 2 Mile and both finished 3rd overall.

Ken McEachern has made the cold winter races much more comfortable for those working the registration and results in the trailer by loaning a butane catalytic heater for our use. Thanks a bunch, Ken.

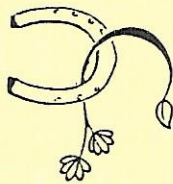

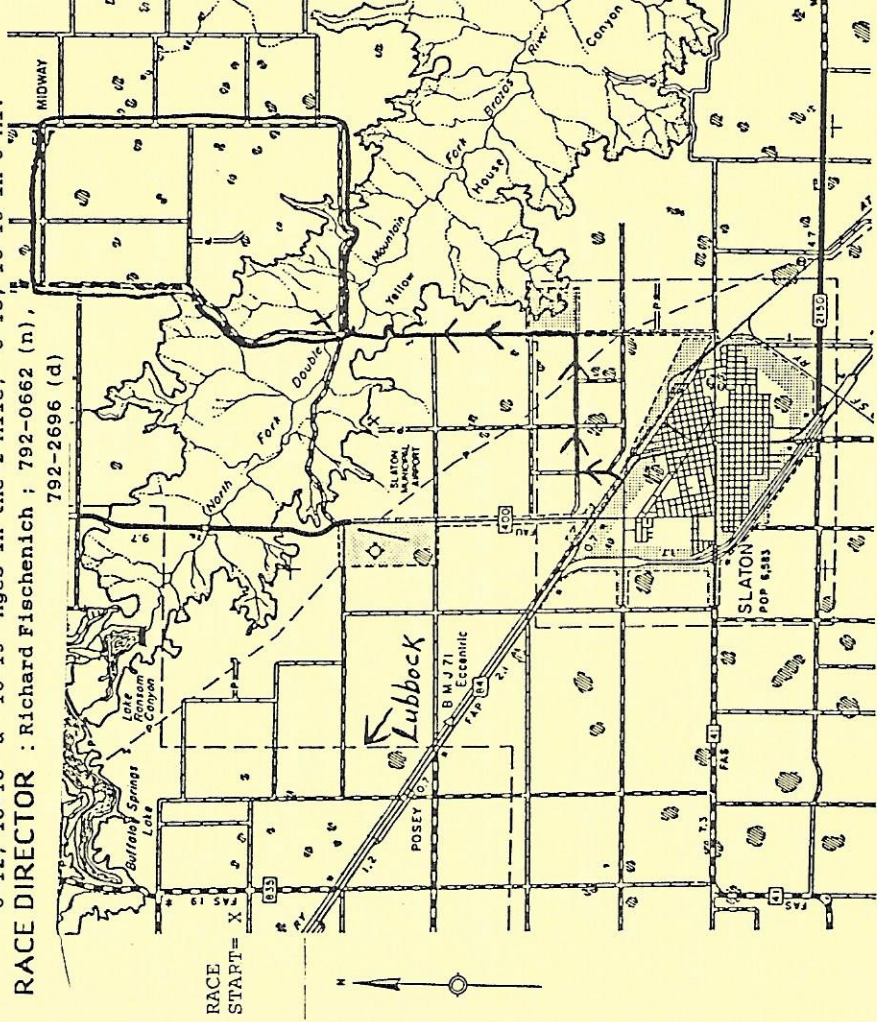
