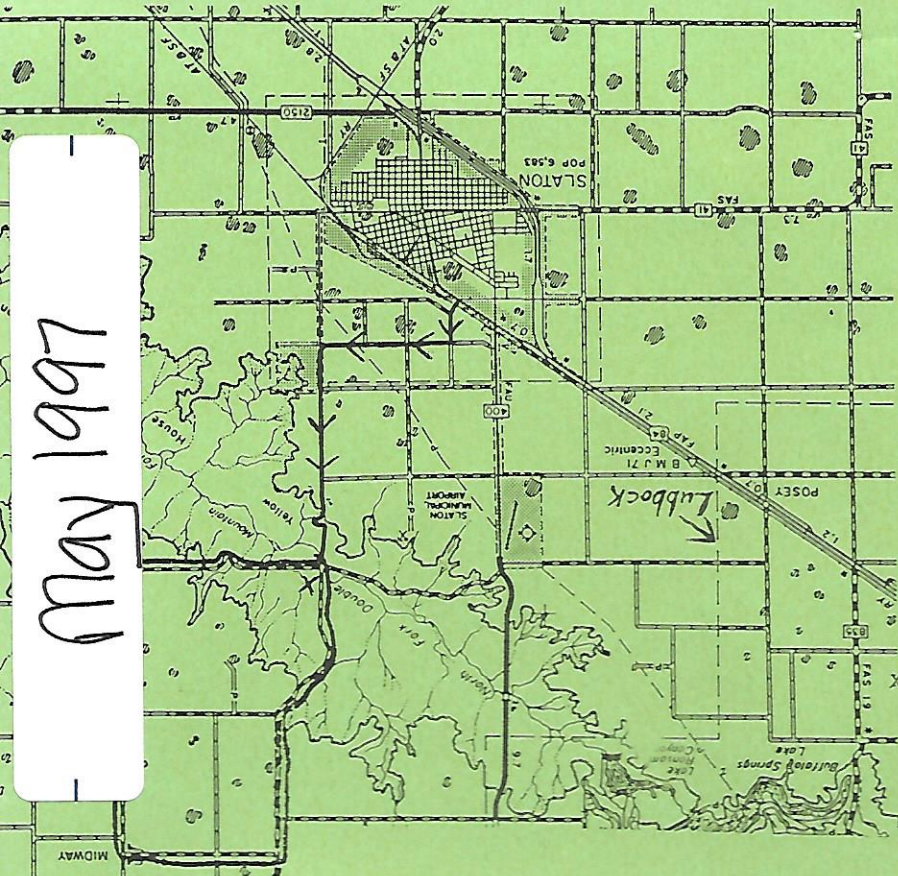

First I want to commend the volunteers that were out Saturday at the Flight Line Races. It was cold, windy and downright miserable. Attendance was down but volunteer spirits were high. It sure made a difference to this runner during the long trek during the 1/2 marathon. If runners thought it was cold on the course, it was definitely colder for those just standing around. Again, a heart felt thanks!

Speaking of volunteers, the **Buffalo Springs Lake Triathlon** is just around the corner on June 29<sup>th</sup>. I am again coordinating the volunteers for the 7 aid stations on the run portion of the event. I will need a minimum of 5 volunteers per station or 35 total. Dwayne Oakeley has already volunteered to man the station at the 5 mile mark. What I need are coordinators for each of the remaining 6 stations who would help get volunteers for their aid station. Mike Greer has agreed to provide a limited budget for each station to develop a unique and interesting design or theme and be decorated accordingly. This would make it more interesting for triathlon competitors. There could even be a prize for the best aid station-- to be shared by the station's volunteers. Please give me a call if you can help. I need to know now. This is an important fund raiser for the club and provides us with a lot of visibility in the local and national athletic community.

My **Dash Against Drug Abuse** races are coming up May 17<sup>th</sup> at Canyon Lake 6 (same location as the Hot Dam Runs in August. This event will have a 3 mile and 6 mile run (1 or 2 laps around the lake). Noncompetitive walkers can participate in the 3 miler. I did get the Lubbock Regional Council on Alcohol and Drug Abuse to change the award categories from 10 year to 5 year age groups. I will need 12 volunteers I to help me. Please call!

We will be paying the registration fees for George Jury and Ron Key to attend the annual convention of the Road Runners Club of America in Colorado Springs. They were going to be in the area anyway and the Board thought this might encourage them to attend some of the many excellent workshops conducted at the meeting. - 7) Full time student status; at least 12 hours undergrad
- 8) Restriction: Recipient must have a verified Financial Need

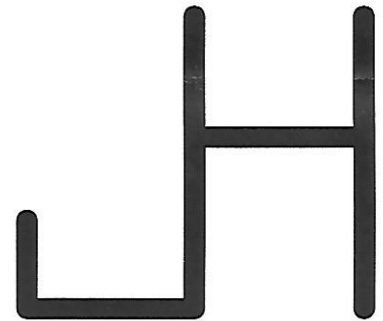
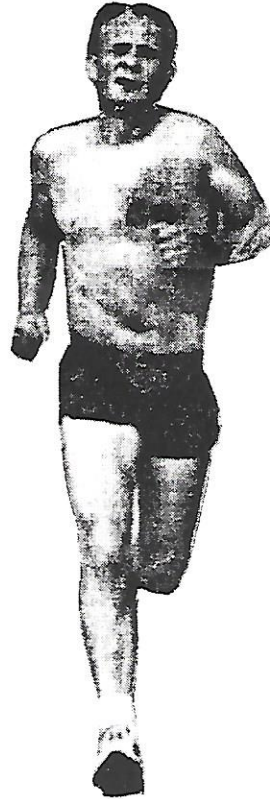
