
1st Annual Phi 742-3641 Red Raider Road Race 10 Kilometer (6.2 mile) Run Homecoming...September 25, 1982

Date: Saturday September 25 1982

Starting Time: 9:00 a.m.

Registration: A \$5.00 minimum donation to the Tech Loyalty Fund. (A gift of \$25.00 will also entitle entrant to membership in the Ex-Students Assn.) Early registration is preferred. Race packets may be picked up on Friday, September 24th in the Tech University Center from 10:00 a.m. til 8:00 p.m. or on Saturday morning. Late registration will also be available at that time or on Saturday morning from 7:00-8:30 a.m.

Course: The starting line is on Boston Avenue between the Tech Library and the University Center. A loop inside the campus, then down Main Street to Avenue L, and return up Broadway along the Homecoming Parade route to finish near the Broadway entrance fountain. A very flat, fast course with an asphalt surface. Race Will Be Locally Televised On Channel 28!!! Homecoming Parade will follow the running of the race.

Divisions (age as of 9-25-82): Men: 19 and under; 20-29; 30-34; 35-39; 40-44; 45-49; 50-54; 55-59; 60 and over. Women: 19 and under; 20-29; 30-39; 40-49; 50 and over.

Awards: Olympic-style medallions to the first five finishers in the 19-and-under and each ten-year age division for both men and women. Medallions to the first three finishers in all other divisions. In addition, Nike will award a pair of running shoes to the winners of each division.

Awards Presentations: September 25th at 12:00 noon in the University Center Courtyard, Tech campus.

Aid Stations: At 2 and 4 mile points and at the finish line. Split Times: At every mile mark.

Results: Complete computerized results booklet available at the awards ceremony to all participants.

Sponsors: Nike and Lubbock Beverage Company. Race organized and supervised by the West Texas Running Club; route aid provided by Phi Epsilon Kappa physical education fraternity and the U.S. Army ROTC.


